ALCITIZENSA KENYANS BY BIRTH A TRAVEL AUTHORIZA Kenya must not

inconvenience dual citizen holders.






he Diaspora Ministry was created to look into the affairs of those in the Diaspora. The Kenya Government has introduced a new travel requirement where all foreigners, including dual citizens traveling to the so-called free visa country, must fill out a travel authorization application form and pay a fee of \$34.

Currently, Kenyans in possession of two passports, however, can avoid paying \$34 by producing a Kenyan passport they never used for travel while boarding. That is a security breach because the primary passport used for travel will not bear an arrival stamp. Kenyans, by birth, should not be treated like foreigners who are paying the

same amount just because they have no Kenyan passport. A passport is a travel document, and after using an American or British passport, using a Kenyan passport to avoid \$34 is not legal by any standards. Foreign passport holders should only get an endorsement and the same- permanent on the immigration file. Avoiding a stamp on foreign passports for those naturalized is illegal as it will appear that one never arrived at the destination. Stamping arrival in both passports is also unlawful. Hence, the Kenyan Government must exempt dual citizens from the requirement either by coming up with a dual citizen ship ID or having foreign passports permanently endorsed for those who wish not to have a Kenyan passport.

ged with killing Savanah Nicole Soto and her 22-year-old boyfriend, Matthew Guerra.

The records did not list an attorney for Romanos, and phone calls to numbers matching her address were either disconnected or went to a voice mailbox that was full.

The arrest comes two weeks after the bodies of Soto and Guerra were discovered in a car in the parking lot of a San Antonio apartment complex. Both had gunshot wounds to the head. Authorities have previously said the deaths appeared to be the result of a drug deal.

Soto's family has said she was

a week overdue to deliver her baby and had been scheduled to have an induced labor when she went missing.

Christopher Preciado, 19, was arrested earlier this month and charged with capital murder. His father, Ramon Preciado, 53, was also arrested at that time and charged with abusing and helping to destroy or conceal a corpse.



Higher population-wide immunity has meant fewer hospitalizations even with high virus spread, and the sharp decline of COVID test results reported to authorities has made case counts far less relevant.

He lost to former North Eastern Provincial Commissioner Maurice Makhanu in the 1988 Kenyan general election after Bungoma South constituency was renamed Kanduyi. Sifuna recaptured the seat during the first multi-party 1992 Kenyan general election on a Ford Asili ticket.

Sifuna went to Sang'alo School and Nalondo Intermediate School before he moved to Mariri College in Uganda, where he sat for the Cambridge General Certificate of Education (CGCE) examination. He was a fully trained chartered accountant, a Fellow

Azimio leader Raila Odinga commemorated the late Sifuna as a towering figure in the struggle for

Kenya's second liberation. He stated, "Deeply saddened by the passing of Hon. Lawrence Simiyu Sifuna, a former MP, a key figure in the second liberation, defender of the people, and a life member of ODM. 

AFRICACUP OF CONTROL NATIONS ** ROARS INTO LIFE. CONTROL CONTR

he 34th edition of the Total Energies Africa Cup Of Nations takes center stage in Ivory Coast starting on 13 January 2024.

The continental showpiece is the main international men's association football competition in Africa and host nation Ivory Coast battles Guinea Bissau in the first game of the biennial football jamboree.

The 24 team tournament has 6 groups of four teams each and after 3 match days, top two teams in each group qualify automatically to the round of 16 while four of the 3rd best place teams also make it to the knockout rounds. The matches will be held at six stadiums across five cities. The Capital Abidjan offers two venues the Felix Houphet-Boigny stadium and the Alassane Ouattara Stadium which will also host the final on the 11th of February 2024. Yamoussokoro Bouke, Korhogo and San Pe-

Ivory Coast football president Yacine Idriss Diallo says the country is 'ready' for AFCON 2023 and gives thoughts on Africa potentially hosting World Cup 2038. "This event means a lot of things for our country, it's a very important event.", Diallo told FourFourTwo

"Since 2014 when it was decided that Ivory Coast would organize this competition, our country put in a lot of money. But more than money, we put our heart in this organization. And I can say that we are ready. We're really ready. I can


say that.", Diallo added

AFCON last came to Ivory Coast in 1984 and hasn't been back since. Back then only two venues were used for an eight team tournament. Those two grounds the Felix Houphet-Boigny stadium in Abidjan and Stade de Bouake (now Stade de la Paix), have been renovated and will be host venues again, alongside four newly built grounds. And for the first time during AF-CON, Video Assistant Refereeing will be in use during matches.

Meanwhile all 52 matches will be broadcast live on Su-

persport after MultiChoice secured the rights to broadcast the continent's showpiece tournament. MultiChoice reached a commercially viable agreement with rightsholders, New World TV (NWTV), to broadcast the 34th edition of Africa's premier men's football competition taking place in Ivory Coast.

Host and 2 time African champions Ivory Coast will be one of the tournament favorites and with the home support coupled with a star studded squad, the Elephants will be expected to go far and even possibly win the title. De-



fending champions Senegal captained by Sadio Mane who recently married his long time girlfriend ahead of AFCON, will be a team to beat but however having reached two consecutive AFCON finals in 2019 and 2022, questions will be on weather Aliou Cisse's men still have the motivation to go far again at this tournament.

Qatar 2022 World Cup semi-finalist and highest ranked African nation Morocco, are arguably the biggest favorites. And with 2023 CAF African Coach Of The Year Walid Regragui steering the wheel, the Atlas Lions will likely roar than ever before and add to their lone title which they won in 1976. Liverpool star Mohammed Salah who lost the 2017 and 2022 finals respectively will be eager on reaching another final and win it thus putting an icing on the cake on what has been a glittering career for the Egyptian.

The likes of Nigeria, Ghana, Tunisia, Algeria, Cameroon who all have won the tournament before will too be in contention for the winners medal while the likes of South Africa and Zambia will be expected to perform from Southern Africa and try to add their 1996 and 2012 titles.



The Biden administration spared no time in attempting to shift blame toward Republicans over America's national debt reaching a historic high of \$34 trillion this week despite President Biden having been in office for nearly three full years. If you think about it, Republican tax cuts are responsible for about 90% of it — of the increase in the debt as a share of the economy over the last two decades, excluding emergency spending," White House press secretary Karine Jean-Pierre claimed during Wednesday's press briefing.
