

# Olympian pleads guilty to sexually molesting young boys at Camp Greylock in the 1970s

and longtime track coach will spend as many as 11 years in state prison after pleading guilty to charges of sexually molesting young boys at a sports camp in western Massachusetts in the 1970s, abuse that was laid bare by the emotional testimony of several victims.

Olympian

Conrad Mainwaring, who was a hurdler for Antigua and Barbuda in the 1976 Summer Olympics in Montreal, faced 12 counts of indecent assault and battery on a child over 14 and four counts of indecent assault and battery on a child under 14 in Berkshire Superior Court. The charges involved nine male victims.

"He used his Olympic status to

Mainwaring molested campers from 1975-1979 while working as a counselor at Camp Greylock in Becket. Authorities have said they believe there are "many other victims" in several states and outside the United States.

Some of the camp victims — who were as young as 13 and as old as 19 — testi-God at Thursday's hearing.

abuse young boys," District Attorney Timothy Shugrue told the court. "He chose young, attractive, athletic boys, young men because he knew, at least he thought he knew, they would not speak up. This was his opportunity for self-gratification, a fraud at the expense of many, many lives."

In a pattern that repeated itself over the years, Shugrue detailed case after case in which Mainwaring leveraged his Olympic credentials as part of a grooming technique used on boys attending Camp Greylock, making the youngsters believe that the sexual assault would make them better athletes. The abuse took place in the woods around the camp, in a van, and near a tennis court,

among other places.

After details of the cases were presented, Mainwaring, in a wheelchair and wearing a mask, said "yes" when asked by the judge if he committed the offenses laid out in court. He then said "guilty" after each of the charges was read out.

Mainwaring, a 72-year-old Los Angeles resident and United Kingdom national, will serve his sentences on the multiple charges concurrently. But Judge John Agostini said it was "probably a life sentence" given Mainwaring's age.

"I was pleased to see the special counsel make clear the stark differences between this case and Trump's," he said, "The special counsel in my case decided against moving forward with any charges. This matter is now closed." He banged the podium with a fist.



tigating President Joe Biden's handling classified documents has

concluded that no criminal charges are warranted in the matter and said they wouldn't be even if the Department of Justice didn't have a policy barring the prosecution of sitting presidents.

That conclusion was revealed in a 345-page report that the Justice Department released on Thurs-

But while the report withheld condemnation of Biden on legal grounds, it presented a harsh portrait of his conduct and mental faculties. Biden improperly took classified material related to the 2009 Afghanistan troop surge and shared classified information

with the ghostwriter of his 2017 memoir. The report also includes photos of classified documents in insecure places, including a cardboard box in Biden's garage and a filing cabinet under his TV.

In the report, Special Counsel Robert Hur, a well-respected former U.S. Attorney, explained the president's "lapses in attention and vigilance demonstrate why former officials should not keep classified materials unsecured at home and read them aloud to others, but jurors could well conclude that Mr. Biden's actions were unintentional."

But he said that Biden would make a defense that many jurors would find sympathetic. Biden's memory lapse was a

common theme throughout Hur's report. He writes that Biden did not remember when he was vice president or, "even within several years," when his son Beau died. Biden, Hur writes, "appeared hazy when describing the Afghanistan debate that was once so important to him." He predicted that Biden's attorneys "would emphasize these limitations in his recall" if they were called upon to defend him at trial. One of those attorneys, Bob Bauer, took umbrage with the portrayal, accusing Hur of "essentially, 'trashing' the subject of an investigation" with extraneous, unfounded and irrelevant critical commentary." 



# RONALD GEDION NGALA

#### Kenya African Democratic Union (KADU) was formed with Ngala as its leader, in opposition to KANU.

onald Gideon Ngala (1923– 1972) was a Kenyan politician who was the leader of the Kenya African Democratic Union political party from its creation in 1960 until its dissolution in 1964. Early career

Ngala was born in 1922 at Gotani in Giriama country. In 1929 the family moved to Vishakani near Kaloleni, which was to be Ngala's home for the rest of his life. Ngala attended The Alliance High School and Makerere University College where he gained a teaching diploma.

He worked as a teacher in Kenya's coastal region and later became headmaster of Mbale Secondary School in Taita-Taveta District. In 1952 he was transferred to Buxton School in Mombasa where he served as the principal.

Political career Legislative Council

Ngala began his national career by being elected to the Legislative Council in 1957. In the 1957 elections

Ronald Ngala was made **Minister of Cooperatives** and Social Services in the **Kenyatta government.[9]** He went on to become one of KANU's vice-presidents at the 1966 Limuru Conference in which Oginga Odinga was ejected from KANU.[10] Ngala remained active in the government until he died in a road accident in 1972.[9] The circumstances of Ngala's death in 1972 were suspicious, but nobody was arrested or charged, and there was no inquiry.

to the legislative council, Ngala was elected to represent the Coast Rural constituency.

Following these elections, Ngala, along with Tom Mboya, Oginga Odinga, Lawrence Oguda, Masinde Muliro, Daniel Arap Moi, Benard Mate and James Miumi formed the African Elected Members Organisation (AEMO) and signed a controversial press statement declaring Kenya's Lyttelton constitution on which they had been elected, void. One of the declarations of AEMO was that none of the African elected members of the legislative council would take any ministerial office. This constitutional crisis led to the first Lancaster House conference in 1960 at which the African delegation sought a new constitution for Kenya.

At the Lancaster House conference, the ban on nationwide African political parties was lifted and the African delegation agreed to form the Kenya African National Union (KANU). Ngala was appointed to the

committee which drafted KANU's constitution and at a meeting held on 14 May 1960, in Kiambu he was elected as the party's treasurer in absentia which he declined having expected to be appointed the chairman. Daniel Moi also declined the assistant chairman slot. They later formed KADU.

After the formation of KANU, a number of smaller parties formed which represented the interests of minority tribes. At a meeting of the leaders of these parties held in Ngong on 25 June 1960, the Kenya African Democratic Union (KADU) was formed with Ngala as its leader, in opposition to KANU.

At the 1961 legislative council elections KADU led by Ngala won 11 seats to KANU's 19, however, the leaders of KANU refused to form any government until Jomo Kenyatta was released from house arrest. KADU under Ngala agreed to form a government and Ngala became Leader of Government Business and

later Chief Minister. Jomo Kenyatta was released from house arrest later in 1961 and became president of KANU. Under Kenyatta's leadership KANU won 83 of the 129 seats in the national assembly at the 1963 elections. On 12 November 1964 six key members of KADU crossed the floor to KANU. The leaders of KADU, including Ronald Ngala, Masinda Muliro and Daniel Arap Moi decided to dissolve KADU and join KANU.

Ronald Ngala was born in the coastal town of Kilifi in the British colony of Kenya. He was educated at Alliance High School and at Makerere University College, where he received a diploma in teaching. He then began a teaching career (1949-1954), rising to the positions of headmaster of the Buxton School (1955-1956) and of supervisor of schools (1957-1958).

During the 1950s, national political parties were banned in the British colony, but regional parties were allowed in some areas. African and non-African groups were competing for the chance to influence Kenya's future. Ngala began his national career by being elected to the Legislative Council in 1957.



# Haley vows to stay in race following 'embarrassing' Nevada defeat.

#### Haley lost Nevada's Republican primary handily on Tuesday even though she was the only candidate listed on the ballot.

ikki Haley's presidential campaign on Wednesday brushed off her mortifying defeat in Nevada's primary and said the former United Nations am-

bassador would press ahead with her longshot challenge to former U.S. President Donald Trump.

Haley lost Nevada's Republican primary handily on Tuesday even though she was the only candidate listed on the ballot. She secured just 31% in the contest, well behind the 63% of the ballots cast for "none of these candidates," according to Nevada election officials.

No delegates were at stake in the primary, making Haley's defeat more symbolic than meaningful. Trump appears poised to capture all of Nevada's 26 delegates when the state party holds a separate caucus proceeding on Thursday, which will further diminish Haley's long-term prospects as a candidate.

The Trump campaign made no effort to get people out to vote in the primary, according to Nevada party insiders. Trump at a Jan. 27 rally in Las Vegas told the crowd not to show up for it, but instead focus on the caucuses.

Despite that, almost 44,000 people cast a ballot in the primary for "none" of the candidates, more than double the voters who



came out for Haley.

A spokesperson for Haley, Olivia Perez-Cubas, downplayed Haley's loss, arguing that the process favored Trump.

"Even Donald Trump knows that when you play penny slots, the house wins. We didn't bother to play a game rigged for Trump," Perez-Cubas said. "We're full steam ahead

in South Carolina and beyond."

Haley has focused on winning her home state of South Carolina, where she served for six years as governor. Polls, however, have shown Trump with a commanding lead ahead of the Feb. 24 primary there. Haley's team had spent considerable energy in recent days trying to manage expectations

in Nevada, where opinion polls had consistently shown her trailing Trump by wide margins, even by the standards of a modern Republican Party dominated by the former president.

middle school teacher has pleaded guilty to sexually abusing a 14-year-old male student, authorities said.

Megan Pauline Jordan, 25, faces 50 years in prison after pleading guilty Tuesday to four felony counts of carnal knowledge of a minor and one felony count of indecent liberties with a minor, the Henrico County Commonwealth's Attorney's Office said in a statement obtained by WVVA, WRIC and the Richmond-Times Dispatch.

Jordan was arrested in June 2023. Henrico County police said in a press release at the time that the former teacher at Hungary Creek Middle School engaged in a sexual relationship with her 14-year-old male student during the 2022-2023 school year.

According to a statement from Henrico

County Commonwealth's Attorney Shannon Taylor, investigators learned that on several occasions, Jordan would go to the boy's house and have "sexual intercourse with the student," WVVA reports. Her DNA was also reportedly recovered from his bed

"I must recognize the brave action of those who brought this matter to the attention of Henrico Police Division," Taylor said in a statement, also obtained by WRIC. "We are always asking people if they see something unusual, or not quite right, to say something. Because of their efforts, this predator is off the streets, out of our schools, and will be held accountable for her actions."





'Looks like Donald Trump just won Iowa. He's the clear front runner on the other side at this point. But here's the thing: this election was always going to be you and me vs. extreme MAGA Republicans. It was true yesterday and it'll be true tomorrow,' Biden noted on his social media accounts.

He ended his observation with a plea for donations to his re-election bid. Trump, meanwhile, used his victory on Monday night to call on the Republican Party to unite behind him so he can 'take the country' back from Biden.

As Republicans in the Senate torpedoed a border deal they had demanded, the bid by their counterparts in the House to impeach Alejandro Mayorkas, the homeland security secretary, collapsed amid Republican defections.

The paralysis left the fate of aid to Ukraine and Israel in peril, closing off what had been seen as the best remaining avenue on Capitol Hill for approval of critical military assistance to U.S. allies.



Then came one last bruising blow. Minutes after Republicans fell one vote short of impeaching Mayorkas — a punishment the party has promised its base ever since winning the majority — the House defeated legislation they put forward to send \$17.6 billion in military assistance to Israel. The measure fell to opposition from Democrats who called it a cynical political ploy to undermine efforts to pass a broader foreign military aid bill including Ukraine. They were joined by a clutch of

who opposed the mea-

sure because the money was not paired with spending cuts.

Taken together, the events that unfolded on Capitol Hill on Tuesday offered a vivid portrait of congressional disarray instigated by Republicans, who are bent on opposing President Joe Biden at every turn but lack a large enough majority or the unity to work their will.

They have sought to kill bipartisan efforts to send more military aid to Ukraine and to forge a compromise to secure the border against an influx of migrants, hard-right Republicans, proposing instead to help only Israel and to

push for the removal of Biden's top immigration official. The backto-back defeats Tuesday showed that while they are adept at thwarting action on critical issues, they are hard-pressed to address any.

The paralysis left the fate of aid to Ukraine and Israel in peril, closing off what had been seen as the best remaining avenue on Capitol Hill for approval of critical military assistance to U.S. allies.

*In a statement,* Johnson blamed Democrats for opposing the aid to Israel, which he said sent a "rebuke to our closest ally in the Middle East at their time of great need." He said Republicans had only unveiled an Israel aid bill devoid of spending cuts as "a major concession" given "the gravity of the situation."

But he left the Capitol without addressing what appeared to be a calamitous miscalculation on the impeachment vote, which had been little more than a political exercise given that the Democratic-lea Senate would be all but certain to acquit Mayorkas.

## Jesus retreated to a garden to pray.

# Garden of Gethsemane is an episode in the life of Jesus.

which occurred after the Last Supper and before his betrayal and arrest, all part of the Passion of Jesus leading to his crucifixion and death. This episode is described in the three Synoptic Gospels in the New Testament.

According to these accounts, Jesus, accompanied by Peter, John and James, enters the garden of Gethsemane on the Mount of Olives where he experiences great anguish and prays to be delivered from his impending suffering, while also accepting God's will.

This episode is a significant event in Christian tradition, especially in Catholic devotional practices. The agony of Jesus in the Garden is the first station of the Scriptural Way of the Cross (modern version of the Via Crucis) and the first "sorrowful mystery" of the Dominican Rosary, and it is the inspiration for the Holy Hour devotion in the Eucharistic adoration. It has been a frequent theme in Christian art depicting the life of Jesus.

According to the Synoptic Gospels, immediately after the Last Supper, Jesus retreated to a garden to pray. Each gospel offers a slightly different account re-

garding narrative details. The gospels of Matthew and Mark identify this place of prayer as Gethsemane. Jesus was accompanied by three Apostles: Peter, John and James, whom he asked to stay awake and pray.

He moved "a stone's throw away" from them, where he felt overwhelming sadness and anguish, and said "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass me by. Nevertheless, let it be as You, not I, would have it." Then, a little while later, he said, "If this cup cannot pass by, but I must drink it, Your will be done!" (Matthew 26:42; in Latin Vul-

gate: fiat voluntas tua). He said this prayer thrice, checking on the three apostles after each prayer and finding them asleep.

He commented: "The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak". An angel came from heaven to strengthen him. During his agony as he prayed, "His sweat was, as it were, great drops of blood falling down upon the ground" (Luke 22:44).

In Roman Catholic tradition, the Agony in the Garden is the first Sorrowful Mystery of the Rosary and the First Station of the Scriptural Way of the Cross (second station in the Philippine version). Catholic tradition includes specific prayers and devotions. These Acts of Reparation to Jesus Christ do not involve a petition for a living or dead beneficiary, but aim to "repair the sins" against Jesus.



# PROSTATE CANCER.


If your current weight is healthy, work to maintain it by choosing a healthy diet and exercising most days of the week. If you need to lose weight, add more exercise and reduce the number of calories you eat each day.

Prostate cancer is cancer that occurs in the prostate. The prostate is a small walnut-shaped gland in males that produces the seminal fluid that nourishes and transports sperm.

Prostate cancer is one of the most common types of cancer. Many prostate cancers grow slowly and are confined to the prostate gland, where they may not cause serious harm. However, while some types of prostate cancer grow slowly and may need minimal or even no treatment, other types are aggressive and can spread quickly.

Prostate cancer that's detected early — when it's still confined to the prostate gland — has the best chance for successful treatment.

Exercise improves your overall health, helps you maintain your weight and improves your mood. Try to exercise most days of the week. If you're new to exercise, start slow and work your way up to more exercise time each day.



Symptoms

Prostate cancer may cause no signs or symptoms in its early stages.

Prostate cancer that's more advanced may cause signs and symptoms such as:
Trouble urinating
Decreased force in the stream of urine
Blood in the urine
Blood in the semen
Bone pain

Losing weight without trying

Erectile dysfunction
It's not clear what causes
prostate cancer.

Doctors know that prostate cancer begins when cells in the prostate develop changes in their DNA. A cell's DNA contains the instructions that tell a cell what to do. The changes tell the cells to grow and divide more rapidly than normal cells do. The abnormal cells continue living, when other cells would die.

The accumulating abnormal cells form a tumor that

can grow to invade nearby tissue. In time, some abnormal cells can break away and spread (metastasize) to other parts of the body.

Factors that can increase your risk of prostate cancer include:

Older age. Your risk of prostate cancer increases as you age. It's most common after age 50.

Race. For reasons not yet determined, Black people have a greater risk of prostate cancer than do people of other races. In Black people, prostate cancer is also more likely to be aggressive or advanced.

Family history. If a blood relative, such as a parent, sibling or child, has been diagnosed with prostate cancer, your risk may be increased. Also, if you have a family history of genes that increase the risk of breast cancer (BRCA1 or BRCA2) or a very strong family history of breast cancer, your

risk of prostate cancer may be higher.

Obesity. People who are obese may have a higher risk of prostate cancer compared with people considered to have a healthy weight, though studies have had mixed results. In obese people, the cancer is more likely to be more aggressive and more likely to return after initial treatment.

Incontinence. Both prostate cancer and its treatment can cause urinary incontinence. Treatment for incontinence depends on the type you have, how severe it is and the likelihood it will improve over time. Treatment options may include medications, catheters and surgery.





hrough the first month of the season, the Indianapolis Colts relied on running back Zack Moss to fill the shoes of a superstar, and now pe's set to hit the free-agent market

he's set to hit the free-agent market during the 2024 offseason.

As the early-season drama surrounding Jonathan Taylor and the Colts front office raged on, Moss stepped up in a big way for the first five weeks as the starting running back.

Even following Taylor's return to his normal role as the starter during the second half of the season, Moss is open to a return to the Colts.

"If I do come back here," Moss said via Nate Atkins of The Indianapolis Star. "It would be great."

Entering Week 6 of the regular season, Moss' 466 rushing yards trailed only Christian McCaffrey (553) for the league lead. In fact, Moss ranked second in the NFL in rushing yards (615) through the first nine weeks of the season, which was done despite Taylor having returned in Week 5. Shared from USA today.
