

THE CALL FOR INVESTIGATION REGARDING THE ILL FATED HELICOPTER IN KENYA, IS TO CLEAR DOUBTS.

This not being an isolated incident in the history of Kenya's political assassinations,

Unparalleled demands for a public inquiry over the crash have been called for, and cautions sent to the family, following attempts to obstruct people's will to have no stone left unturned in the efforts to unveil whatever transitioned in the run-up to the General's death.

The face of political assassinations in Kenya was first triggered by Socialism and Capitalism structures conflicting on the manner land was being distributed with a call by socialists for equity soon after the country became independent and started exercising self-rule. Westland's legislator raised the concerns in the house, pointing at the head of state, who was seen on a spree to own vast land for himself.

Pio Gama Pinto, born in Nairobi on 31st March1927, was assassinated on 24th February 1965, aged

38 years of age, was shot at a close point by gunmen outside his gate in Westlands waiting to be opened.

This was viewed as the country's first political martyr.

Joseph Thomas Odhiambo Mboya, former Minister of Jus-



tice, was assassinated on July Njonjo, to direct that Mr. Moi 5th 1969.

Born in Oldonyo Sabuk on August 15th, 1930, he was a Trade Unionist, Educator, Pan-Afriactivist, and a Statesman.

He was one of Kenya's founding fathers.

Nyandarua North.

Born on March 29th, 1929, JM, as famously known, held several positions in the Kenyatta government from Independence in 1963 to his assassination on March 2nd, 1975.



A sense of belonging can be cultivated when one is not treated as a joke. Notably, there is need for women and


men to work together as one to address these problems.







arry Thuku, one of the pioneers of African nationalism in Kenya, was born in the Kambui region of the British colony in 1895. In 1907, the Gospel Missionary Society build a mission center in Kambui, employing Thuku as a herd boy and houseboy. During his childhood employment at the mission center, Thuku learned to read and write. He left for Nairobi in 1911, but at sixteen was sentenced to two years in prison for check-forging.

After serving his two-year prison term, Thuku was employed at the Leader, a colonial newspaper, when he became interested in local and national political affairs. Through the paper he learned of the infighting among European settlers in Kenya over the colony's future.

Harry Thuku (1895 - 14 June 1970) was a Kenyan born in Kiambu, Mitahato village. As a politician, he was one of the pioneers in the development of modern African nationalism in Kenya. He helped found the Young Kikuyu Association and the East African Association before being arrested and exiled from 1922 to 1931 In 1932 he became President of the Kikuyu Central Association, in 1935 founded the Kikuyu Provincial Association, and in 1944 founded the Kenya African Study Union. Opposed to the Mau Mau movement, he later retired to coffee-farming.

In association with Abdalla Tairara, Thuku helped found the Young Kikuyu Association, the first organisation to defend African interests in colonial Kenya. The Young Kikuyu Association was a non-militant group that pursued a peaceful and structured liberation struggle with the government and missions. Its main concern was for the preservation of African-owned land. Thuku argued that land was an important factor of production and that the livelihood of the Kikuyu people, who are primarily farmers, risked being lost. His message reverberated strongly not only within his immediate Kikuyu tribe but also with other farming communities in Kenya and Africa. From 1920 to 1921 Thuku served as the secretary to the Kikuyu Association.

Hamas releases video of hostage Hersh Goldberg-Polin in proof he survived Oct. 7

"Seeing the video of Hersh today is overwhelming. We are relieved to see him alive, but we are also concerned about his health and wellbeing as well as that of all the other hostages



Goldberg-Polin on Wednesday, the first proof that he survived being badly wounded during his capture on October 7.

Goldberg-Polin, then 23, was kidnapped from the Nova music festival during Hamas' attacks on Israel when more than 1,200 people died and more than 200 people were taken hostage.

He is shown in the undat-

Israeli officials say the Oct. 7 attack by Hamas, which caught them by surprise, changed the ground rules of regional conflict. To its enemies, it was Israel's bombing and invasion of Gaza that did that, and it led to increased rocket fire by Hezbollah, Iran's proxy in Lebanon. That in turn drew heavy fire from Israel.



Hostages will live to tell horrific stories

ed video with part of his left arm missing several inches above the hand.

Video filmed on October 7 showed Goldberg-Polin being taken hostage with his arm severely injured. A firsthand account from a young woman, who was in a bunker with him when Hamas attacked, said he had helped to throw grenades out, before his arm was blown off from the elbow down.

The latest video shows Goldberg-Polin sitting in a chair, addressing the camera. Gesturing occasionally with his injured arm, he identifies himself and gives his date of birth and parents' names.

He says he has been "here for almost 200 days," suggesting the video was filmed shortly before Tuesday, the

berg-Polin's hair is cropped short in the video, which is edited with a number of cuts from wide shot to close up. He criticizes the Israeli government of Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, as other Israeli hostages in Hamas propaganda videos have done. Held captive in Gaza for six months, he is almost certainly speaking under du-

He mentions Israeli government ministers sitting down to holiday dinners with their families, an apparent reference to the Jewish holiday of Passover, which began Monday night and is traditionally celebrated with a family din-

He urges his own family to stay strong for him and finishes by saying he hopes he comfort on the holiday.

The Biden administration received the video Monday two days before Hamas made it public - and officials have since been in contact with Goldberg-Polin's family, according to a US official.

The FBI's Hostage Recovery Fusion Cell is running point on examining the video for any potential evidence and information that can be gleaned about Goldberg-Polin and his captivity, the official said.

Goldberg-Polin is among the most recognizable of the 129 hostages who remain in Gaza. Banners and murals are displayed in Jerusalem, saying: "Bring Hersh Home," and his parents Rachel and Jonathan regularly meet top US officials in Washington to was able to give them some press the case of the hostag-

Of the 129 October 7 hostages still being held in Gaza, the Israeli government believes 33 are dead. Following the release of the video, the Goldberg-Polin family demanded immediate action to release their son and the other hostages still held in Gaza.

"Seeing the video of Hersh today is overwhelming. We are relieved to see him alive, but we are also concerned about his health and wellbeing as well as that of all the other hostages and all of those suffering in this region," his parents Rachel Goldberg-Polin and Jon Polin said in a video state-

The Goldberg-Polin family has called on the negotiating parties, including Qatar, Egypt, the United States, Hamas, and Israel, to intensify efforts and strike a deal that would reunite families and end their suffering

Airlines required to refund passengers for canceled, delayed flights.



Good news for airline travelers: Department of Transportation Wednesday announced it is rolling out new rules that will

require airlines to automatically give cash refunds to passengers for canceled and significantly delayed flights.

"This is a big day for America's flying public," said Transportation Secretary Pete Buttigieg at a Wednesday morning news conference. Buttigieg said the new rules -which require prompt refunds -- are the biggest expansion of passenger rights in the department's history.

Airlines can no longer decide how long a delay must be be-

Airlines for America, the trade association for the country's leading passenger and cargo airlines, told **ABC News in a statement** that its members "offer a range of options -- including fully refundable fares." Is said consumers are "given the choice of refundable ticket options with terms and conditions that best fit their needs at first search



fore a refund is issued. Under the new DOT rules, the delays covered would be more than three hours for domestic flights and more than six hours for international flights, the agency said.

This includes tickets purchased directly from airlines, travel agents and third-party sites such as Expedia and Travelocity.

The DOT rules lay out that passengers will be "entitled to a refund if their flight is canceled or significantly changed, and they do not accept alternative transportation or travel credits offered." DOT will also require airlines to give cash refunds if your bags are lost and not delivered within 12 hours.

within seven days, according to the new DOT rules, and must be in cash unless the passenger chooses another form of compensation. Airlines can no longer issue refunds in forms of vouchers or credits when consumers are entitled to receive cash. Airlines will have six months to comply with the new rules. "Passengers deserve to get their money back when an airline owes them -- without headaches or haggling," Buttigieg said in a statement. The DOT said it is also working on rules related to family seating fees, enhancing rights for wheelchair-travel-

ing compensation and amenities if flights are delayed or canceled by airlines.

Buttigieg said the DOT is also protecting airline passengers from being surprised by hidden fees -- a move he estimates will have Americans billions of dollars every

The DOT rules include that passengers will receive refunds for extra services paid for and not provided, such as Wi-Fi, seat selection or inflight entertainment.

Buttigieg said Southwest's fine sets a "new standard" for airlines and passenger rights.

"To be clear, we want the airline sector to thrive. It is why we put so much into helping them survive the pandemic and honestly it's why we're being so rigorous on passenger protection," he said.

Buttigieg reiterated that refund requirements are already the standard for airlines, but the new DOT rules hold the airlines to account and makes sure passengers get the "refunds that are owed to them."



High blood pressure. Also called hypertension, this condition forces the heart to work harder than it should to pump blood through the body. Over time, the extra work can make the heart muscle too stiff or too weak to properly pump blood.

eart failure occurs when the heart muscle doesn't pump blood as well as it should. When this happens, blood often backs up and fluid

can build up in the lungs, causing shortness of breath.

Certain heart conditions gradually leave the heart too weak or stiff to fill and pump blood properly. These conditions include narrowed arteries in the heart and high blood pressure.

Proper treatment may improve the symptoms of heart failure and may help some people live longer. Lifestyle changes can improve quality of life. Try to lose weight, exercise, use less salt and manage stress.

But heart failure can be life-threatening. People with heart failure may have severe symptoms. Some may need a

Prostate Coronary artery disease and heart attack. Coronary artery disease is the most common cause of heart failure. The disease results from the buildup of fatty deposits in the arteries. The deposits narrow the arteries. This reduces blood flow and can lead to heart attack.

heart transplant or a device to help the heart pump blood. Heart failure is sometimes called congestive heart failure.

If you have heart failure, your heart can't supply enough blood to meet your body's needs.

Symptoms may develop slowly. Sometimes, heart failure symptoms start suddenly. Heart failure symptoms may include:

Shortness of breath with activity or when lying down. Fatigue and weakness.

Swelling in the legs, ankles and feet.

Rapid or irregular heartbeat. Reduced ability to exercise. Wheezing.

A cough that doesn't go away or a cough that brings up white or pink mucus with spots of blood.

Swelling of the belly area. Very rapid weight gain from fluid buildup.

Nausea and lack of appetite. Difficulty concentrating or decreased alertness.

Chest pain if heart failure is caused by a heart attack. See your health care provid-

er if you think you might have symptoms of heart failure. Call 911 or emergency medical help if you have any of the following:

Chest pain.

Fainting or severe weakness. Rapid or irregular heartbeat with shortness of breath, chest pain or fainting.

Sudden, severe shortness of breath and coughing up white or pink, foamy mucus. These symptoms may be due to heart failure. But there are many other possible causes.

Don't try to diagnose yourself.

At the emergency room, health care providers do tests to learn if your symptoms are due to heart failure or something else.

Call your health care provider right away if you have heart failure and:

Your symptoms suddenly become worse.

You develop a new symptom.

You gain 5 pounds (2.3 kilograms) or more within a few days.

Heart failure can be caused by a weakened, damaged or stiff heart.

If the heart is damaged or weakened, the heart chambers may stretch and get bigger. The heart can't pump out the needed amount of blood.




