The neighbour says, "Well actually the seat belongs to me. I was supposed to come with my wife, but she passed away. This is the first World Cup Final we haven't been to together

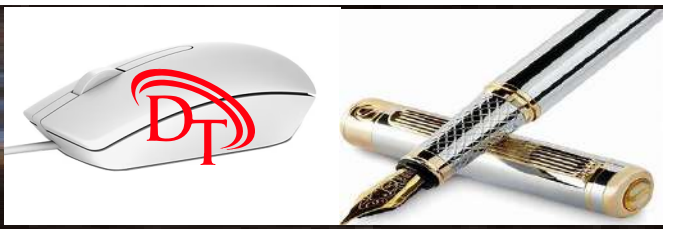

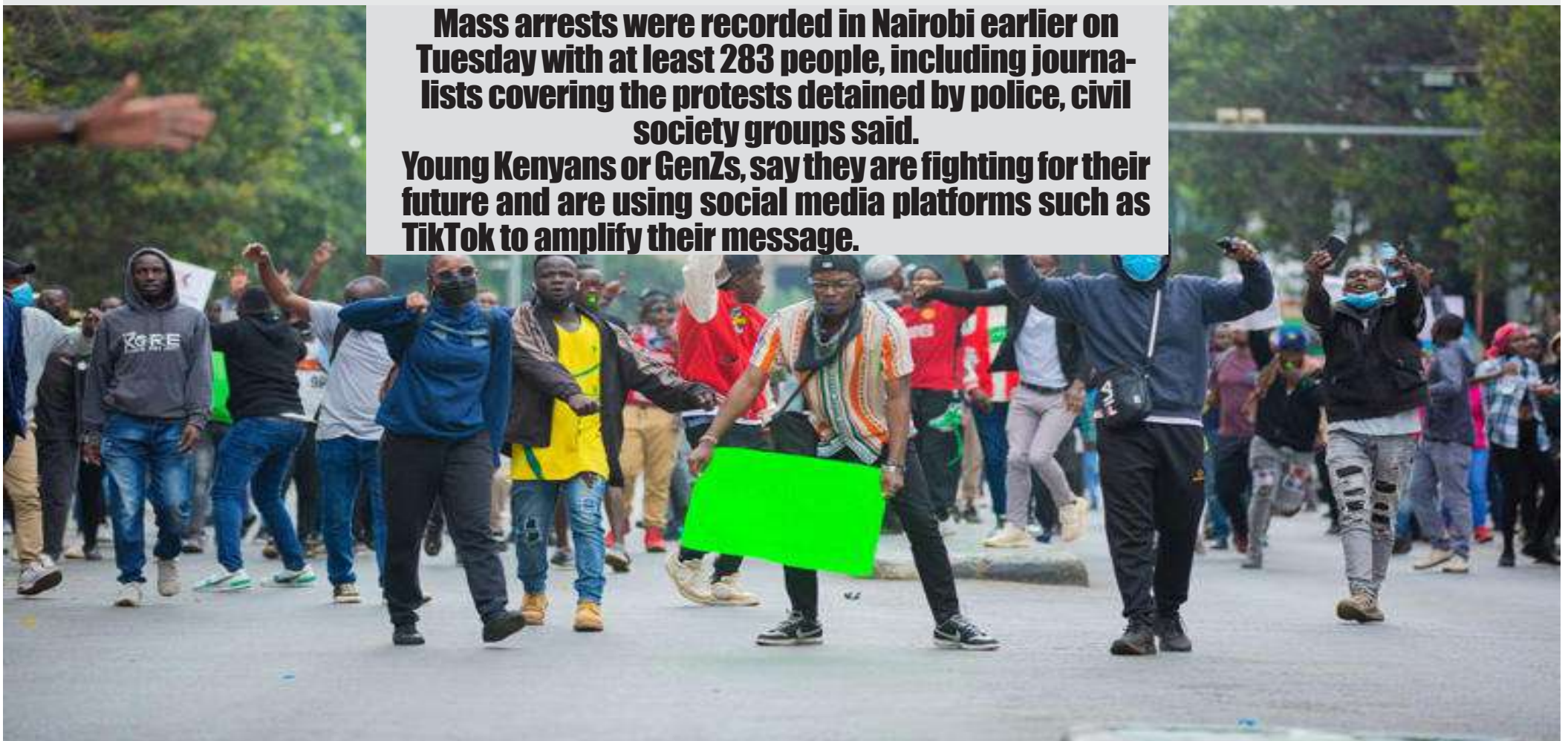

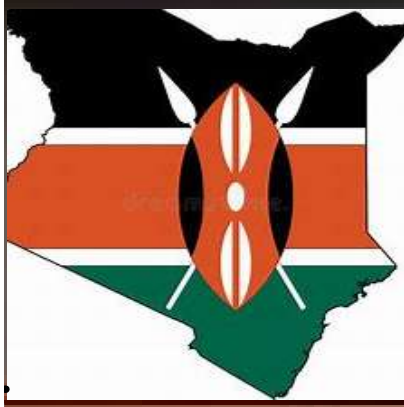

Makhan Singh

Post-independence, Makhan Singh was left out of any national involvement. Heartbroken, he became a social recluse and directed his mind to writing the history of Kenya's trade unionism in his volumes. He died of a heart attack on 18 May 1973 at the age of 59.

E (27 December 1913 – 18 May 1973) Makhan Singh was a Kenyan labour union leader who is credited with establishing the foundations of trade unionism in Kenya.

He is credited to have played a vital role in the Kenyan Freedom Struggle. He was detained by the British colonialists for 11 years from 1950 to 1961 - the longest ever political detention in Kenya's history.

Makhan Singh was born in Gharjakh, a village in Gujranwala District, Punjab to a Sikh family. In 1927, at the age of 13, he moved with his family to Nairobi, a municipality which, since 1905, had functioned as the administrative capital of the British East African protectorate.

From the end of the Second World War he participated in the Indian Freedom Movement from Kenya where he was jailed in Gujarat Jail, he was freed after multiple fasts unto death.

The Indian Trade Union was formed in 1934 and Makhan Singh elected its secretary not long after, in March 1935. Soon, Makhan Singh convinced his nearly 500 fellow unionists to change the name of their association to the Labour Trade Union of Kenya and open membership to all, regardless of race.

Singh's action at both a basic, semantic level and a broader, organizational level signalled his intent to break free of the political and racial narrowness of daily life in colonial

Kenya. To this end, biographer Nazmi Durrani says, the union published its handouts in Kiswahili besides Punjabi, Gujarati and Urdu. This encourages us to believe that Makhan Singh's inclusion of Africans in his trade union activities was not merely symbolic and that he was determined to reach out to as wide a swathe of subjugated races as possible.

He was arrested in 1943 and in January 1945, he was set free. Wasting no time, he took up work as a sub-editor at Jang-i-Azadi, the weekly published by the Punjab Committee of the Communist Party.

Kenya was a centre of Ghadr Party until 1947. Three Punjabis Bishan Singh of village Gakhhal Jalandhar, Ganesh Das and Yog Raj Bali of Rawalpindi were summarily tried and hanged to death in public

in December 1915 for possessing and distributing Ghadr.

In Kenya he had done something unprecedented. In the month of April, Makhan Singh gave a call in Nairobi for Uhuru Sasa, a Kiswahili expression meaning Freedom Now. For the first time, someone had commanded the British to grant complete independence to their territories in East Africa.

In 1935, he formed the Labour Trade Union of Kenya and, in 1949, he and Fred Kubai formed the East African Trade Union Congress, the first central organization of trade unions in Kenya.

After having spoken out in clear and strong terms against British occupation and colonial rule in Kenya on 23 April 1950 at Nairobi's Kaloleni Halls, Makhan Singh was arrest-

ed within 21 days on 15 May. He had inadvertently given the British colonial masters an opportunity to silence him. At a trial in Nyeri, Chanan Singh (later Justice Chanan Singh) defended him eloquently and with rigour. He was acquitted.

While in jail he still organized strikes and fasts. Although the greatest feat of his power was from 1951 to 1955, where he issued the Sector Nairobi, Kenya Trade Union to stop trading with Britain altogether. After he left jail in 1961 he was able to reset his Trade Union although Jomo Kenyatta and him, at the time partners with the same respect in society, were able to negotiate with the British to set up Kenya as a democracy, although he wanted it to be a Communist nation.

He was born on December 27, 1913 in Gharjakh, a town near Gujranwala (Pakistan) in the family of Sudh Singh who went to Kenya in 1920, about two decades after the British took Indian labour to Kenya to lay the railway track from Mombasa to Kisumu to feed their commercial needs. In the 16th century the Portuguese had also imported workers from the then colony of theirs, Goa, to help build the coastal Fort Jesus. But it was in the last years of the 19th century when 37,000 workers and petty tradesmen were introduced from Punjab and Gujarat for the line that is termed by the African tribes and subsequently by Robert Hardy as The Iron Snake. The slithering of this 'snake', passing through the dense forests took life of about 2,500 workmen; roughly four persons per mile of the track. Another 6,500 were injured seriously.

The situation we are in is not different from the French Revolution or the Arab Spring. It does not take a lot of intelligence to understand that the climax of the revolution is the removal of the leadership that has failed the people.

This is not just about the Finance Bill. It is not just about sending innocent young Kenyans to be killed in Haiti. It is not just about the corruption starting at the top. It is not just about the selling of the country to the West. It is not just about the killing of innocent people, including children. It is all the above and a lot more.

I do not have a crystal ball to see how the departure will occur, but deductive reasons are only two possibilities. First, he will understand something clearly, and then, he will surrender. Second, he will remain in power stubbornly and be removed by force.

The first scenario of Ruto leaving peacefully is highly unlikely, going by Ruto's well-known ego. Since the YK 92 days, Ruto has thrived on lies, false hopes, and hypocrisy. In some ways, this has helped him succeed and enrich himself without being caught.

It was ironic that even when the International Criminal Court (ICC) wanted to help us by interdicting him on the crimes he had committed against humanity, we prayed for him and demonstrated for his release even when the surviving victims of his actions then were still in camps. And, of course, Kenyans celebrated with joy when he was let go.

In recent years, he has found solace in the church to make Kenyans (and even his American masters) believe that he has been converted and that they should forget all that he has done in the past. This worked for him for a while

when he complained that he was being persecuted by the Uhuru Government. People gave him the sympathy votes he sought and made him President. Those who knew him well knew that the manipulating Ruto was still prevailing. Yes, the one who at one time was implicated in the Kiambaa Church burning in 2007, where mothers with babies strapped on their backs died. Yes, the one associated with the notorious YK 92 during the days of Moi and later fell out with Jirongo and Moi. Yes, the one that Uhuru warned us about. Yes, the one that Ngugi Wa Thiong'o in 2013 referred to as a consummate hypocritical chameleon in a New York Times article entitled A Dictator's Last Laugh.

That is who we have in power, and he is not leaving, particularly now that he is receiving directives from his masters (read Meg Whitman's shameless message). The American ambassador to Kenya congratulated William Ruto for adhering to what she referred to as "our directives." We all knew that Ruto was a puppet of the West, but it is hard to read such a message from the master's ambassador.

The second scenario of Ruto being ejected out of office is the more likely one. One hopes this will occur sooner than later to avoid too much bloodshed. Will the current revolution get him out in a few months – most likely? One thing I can bet on is that it will not stop until he is out. The longer it takes, the greater will be the suffering of the entire country. It is time to examine some of the ways that Ruto can be ejected out of office.

This can be done constitutionally, as provided in Chapter 6 of the Constitution (section 145.1). To understand how this can be done, I copy and paste it here for reference:

"A member of the National Assembly, supported by at least a third of all the

members, may move a motion for the impeachment of the President--

(a) on the ground of a gross violation of a provision of this Constitution or of any other law;

(b) where there are serious reasons for believing that the President has committed a crime under national or international law; or

(c) for gross misconduct."

The killing of innocent children and the ongoing abductions are enough reasons to justify taking this action. I, however, have no faith in the current parliaments of Ruto puppets to take this bold move. Remember that these are the same people who sang about how excellent the Finance Bill was, and they voted yes to it. When Ruto rejected it, they started singing about his incredible action. They have no power to think and take the right action unless Ruto tells them to, and he is not going for his impeachment.

There may be other ways in between, but I am afraid of only one other scenario. For Ruto to be dragged out of office as was done to other dictators before him like Saddam Hussein of Iraq, Ali Bongo of Gabon, Nicolae Ceausescu of Romania, Zine Ben Ali of Tunisia, Hosni Mubarak of Egypt, and more is a foreseeable eventuality.

The list of your predecessors, Mr. Ruto, is endless. Learn from them and leave quietly. Otherwise, people will remove you by force. Unfortunately, removing a stubborn dictator sometimes calls for interference from the armed forces and suspension of the Constitution. This is not what we want, but it is not a remote idea. It just might happen. If Ruto survives for a short while by force, he will be a lame-duck president, and people will never trust any decision he makes.

He has proven to be a perpetual liar, and people have lost trust in him and his government. You cannot run a go-

vernment that cannot make decisions that people can accept. The best way out is for him and his people to resign before causing more suffering. Please be advised that the revolution is not going to end with you still being in power.

Meanwhile, as the revolution continues until its ultimate end, we need the Independent Electoral and Boundaries Commission (IEBC) in place. I strongly suggest that the four defamed Chereera Four commissioners (Juliana Chereera, Francis Wanderi, Irene Masit, and Justus Nyang'aya) resume office. Their time was not officially up when they were ejected and humiliated by Ruto and his henchmen. Kenyans know that they knew more than they were able to tell and the threatening and dehumanizing conditions they were put through.

American Airlines CEO says the removal of several Black passengers from a flight was 'unacceptable'.

In 2017, the NAACP warned Black travelers about flying on the airline, claiming that several African American passengers had experienced discrimination from airline employees.

American Airlines put an unspecified number of employees on leave for their involvement in an incident

in which several Black passengers were removed from a flight in Phoenix, allegedly over a complaint about body odor.

American CEO Robert Isom wrote in a note to staff that the incident was unacceptable.

"I am incredibly disappointed by what happened on that flight and the breakdown of our procedures," Isom said in the note this week. "It contradicts our values. ... We fell short of our commitments and failed our customers in this incident."

Three Black passengers sued the airline last month, charging that they were removed from the January flight because of racial discrimination. They said they were told that a white male flight attendant had complained about an unidentified passenger's body odor.

The men said they did not know each other and were seated separately while waiting for the plane to depart for New York. The three said they were among eight passengers – all the Black men on the flight, they said – who were told to leave the plane.

After a delay of about an hour, they were allowed back on the plane.

American did not say how many employees were put on leave or describe their job titles. A spokesperson for the airline said, "We are holding those involved accountable,

including removing team members from service."

Isom said American would form an advisory group to focus on the experience of Black customers, to promote the reporting of discrimination allegations, and to improve diversity training to "focus on real-world situations to help recognize and address bias and discrimination."

In his note, which was reported earlier by CBS News, Isom said he had spoken with the president of the NAACP about the incident. The civil rights

group did not immediately respond to a request for comment Thursday.

American has faced allegations of discrimination in the recent past. In 2017, the NAACP warned Black travelers about flying on the airline, claiming that several African American passengers had experienced discrimination from airline employees. American promised to make changes, and the NAACP lifted the advisory nearly nine months later.

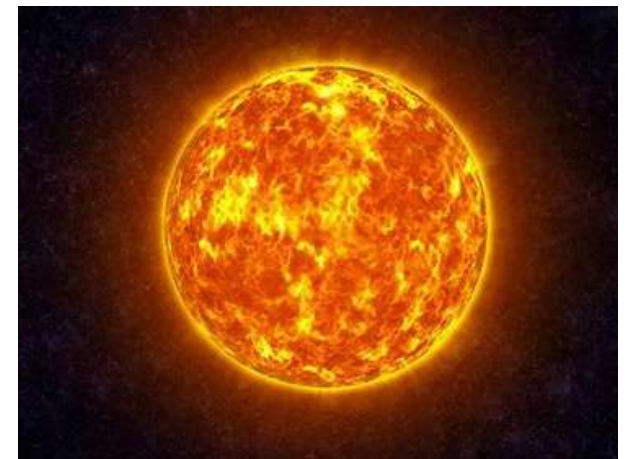
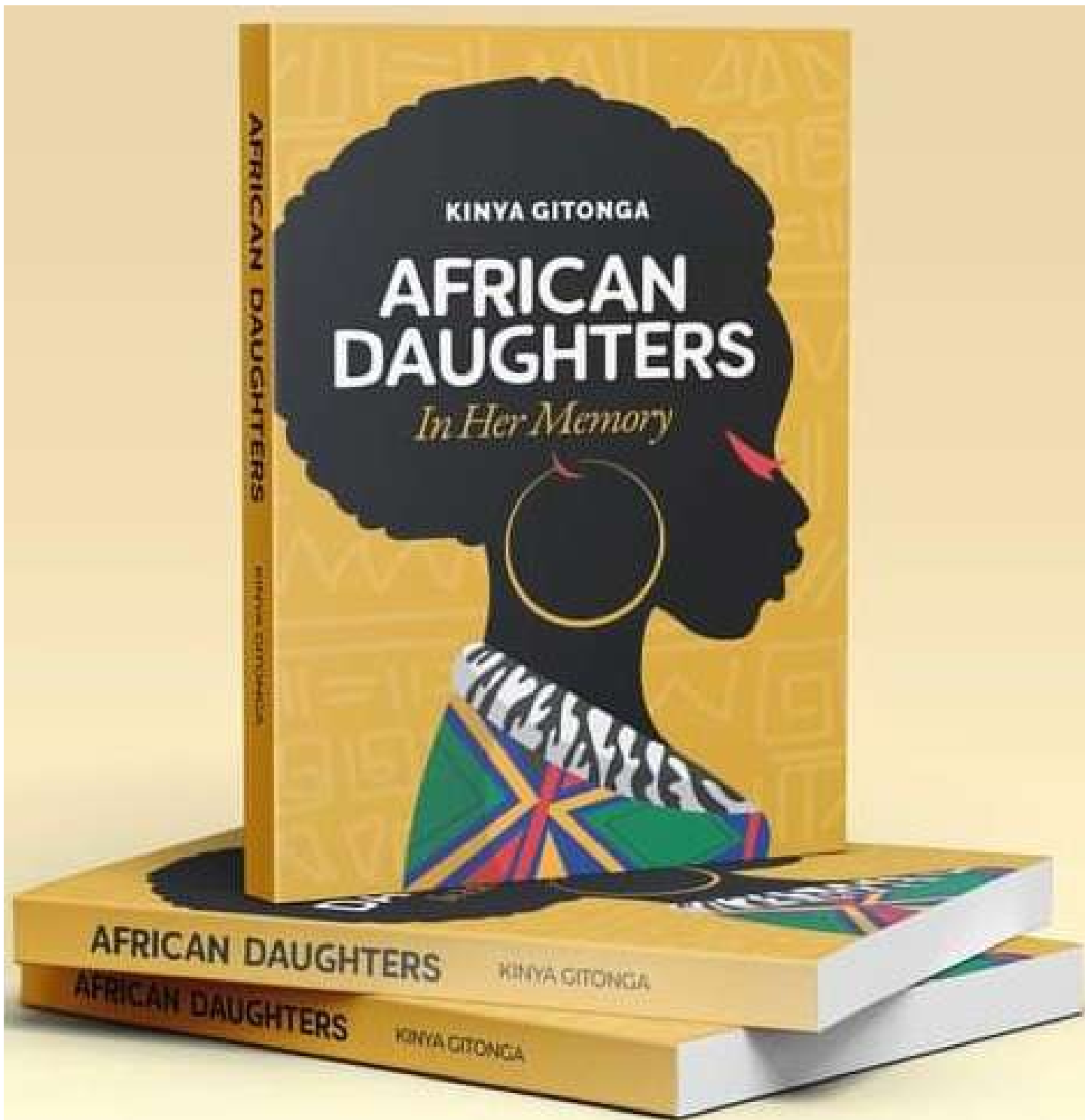

President Joe Biden has received a boost in the polls as voters view him more positively on the hot topics of the 2024 election: the economy and immigration. This is the first time that the president has led Trump in a survey from the news network since October 2023. 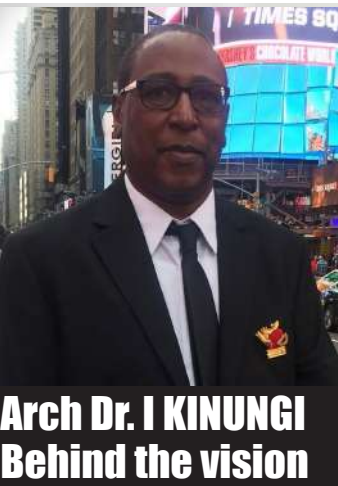
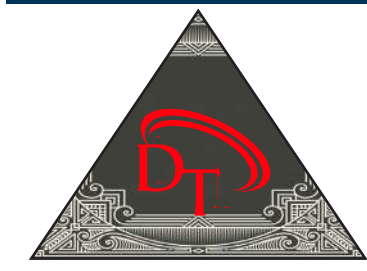

Thousands In Kenya Demonstrate Against Proposed New Taxes.

Thousands of mostly young people demonstrated Thursday in Kenya's capital and across the country against new tax proposals by the administration of President William Ruto in its annual budget legislation. The protests brought Nairobi's central business district to a standstill as horse-riding riot police threw tear-gas canisters and opened water cannons on demonstrators who advanced towards parliament buildings, where lawmakers debated the finance bill.

The protesters, who began their demonstrations in a first round on Tuesday, are demanding that lawmakers vote against the legislation, which is expected to be burdensome for salaried



Lawmakers were debating and voting Thursday on the legislation in its second reading. It is due for its third and final reading next week. Meanwhile, demonstrators tried to breach a security cordon to access parliament buildings, carrying anti-government placards and chanting against Ruto.

Kenyan, entrepreneurs and consumers. They say Ruto has gone back on his pledge to reduce taxes and lower the cost of living. The new taxes would include a 2.75% levy on income for the national medical insurance plan, as well as increased taxes on vegetable oil and fuel, which would increase the cost of production and trickle down to the consumer. Proposals to introduce a 16% value-added tax on bread and a new annual tax on motor vehicles were removed from the legislation Tuesday after a meeting between Ruto and ruling party members. "Our parents have been

taxed dry, yet there's no development to show for it. We reject any additional taxes and will stay on the streets for as long as it takes," Ashley Mwai said. The 19-year-old who has never voted said the new taxes have made her get involved in politics for the first time for the sake of her parents who do not have the energy to join protests. "As much as I'm not earning an income yet, additional taxes will increase the prices of food and transport, making life unbearable for us young people," Mwai said. Businessman Walter Mwangi, 34, said he's struggling to earn a living because taxes

are already crippling his consultancy business. "We are sick and tired," Mwangi said. Lawmakers were debating and voting Thursday on the legislation in its second reading. It is due for its third and final reading next week. Meanwhile, demonstrators tried to breach a security cordon to access parliament buildings, carrying anti-government placards and chanting against Ruto. The president was attending a university event in the southeastern town of Garissa where anti-government protesters lined the street leading to the event venue. Young people also demonstrated in the president's

home turf of Eldoret town, where they told journalists they had been duped into voting for Ruto. Ruto said earlier in the week that the protests were a constitutional right, but that government institutions must carry out their mandate. AP SHARE

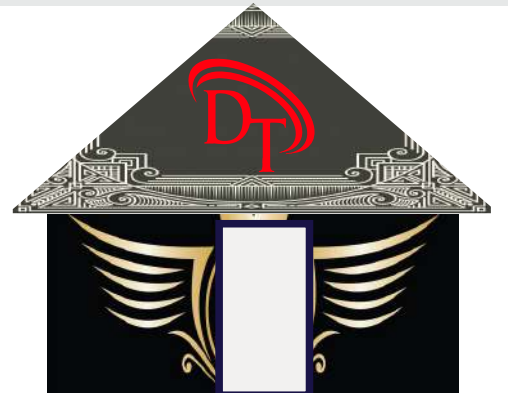

Mental illness, also called mental health disorders, refers to a wide range of mental health conditions — disorders that affect your mood, thinking and behavior. Examples of mental illness include depression, anxiety disorders, schizophrenia, eating disorders and addictive behaviors.



Get regular physical activity on most days of the week

Many people have mental health concerns from time to time. But a mental health concern becomes a mental illness when ongoing signs and symptoms cause frequent stress and affect your ability to function. A mental illness can make you miserable and can cause

problems in your daily life, such as at school or work or in relationships. In most cases, symptoms can be managed with a combination of medications and talk therapy (psychotherapy).
Symptoms
Signs and symptoms of mental illness can vary, depending on the disorder, circumstances and other factors. Mental illness symptoms can affect emotions, thoughts and behaviors. Examples of signs and symptoms include:
Feeling sad or down
Confused thinking or reduced ability to concentrate
Excessive fears or worries, or extreme feelings of guilt
Extreme mood changes of highs and lows

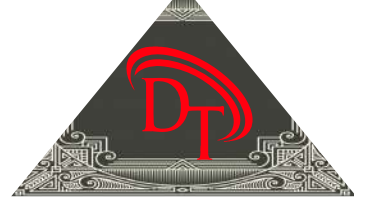
Withdrawal from friends and activities
Significant tiredness, low energy or problems sleeping
Detachment from reality (delusions), paranoia or hallucinations
Inability to cope with daily problems or stress
Trouble understanding and relating to situations and to people
Problems with alcohol or drug use
Major changes in eating habits
Sex drive changes
Excessive anger, hostility or violence
Suicidal thinking
Sometimes symptoms of a mental health disorder appear as physical problems, such as stomach pain, back

pain, headaches, or other unexplained aches and pains.
When to see a doctor
If you have any signs or symptoms of a mental illness, see your primary care provider or a mental health professional. Most mental illnesses don't improve on their own, and if untreated, a mental illness may get worse over time and cause serious problems.



Mental illnesses, in general, are thought to be caused by a variety of genetic and environmental factors:
Inherited traits. Mental illness is more common in people whose blood relatives also have a mental illness. Certain genes may increase your risk of developing a mental illness, and your life situation may trigger it.
Environmental exposures before birth. Exposure to environmental stressors, inflammatory conditions, toxins, alcohol or drugs while in the womb can sometimes be linked to mental illness.
Brain chemistry. Neurotransmitters are naturally occurring brain chemicals that carry signals to other parts of your brain and body. When the neural networks involving these chemicals are impaired, the function of nerve receptors and nerve systems change, leading to depression and other emotional disorders.

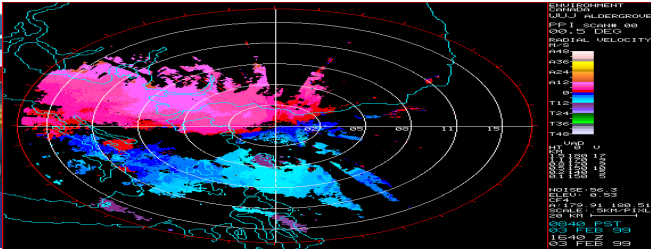

Temperature, rain, snow, fog and wind are all part of weather. Severe weather events such as tornadoes, tropical storms, hurricanes, cyclones, floods, lightning strikes and extreme weather affect us all. In addition to weather forecasts are ozone levels, changing climate conditions and solar winds. Weather warnings are important forecasts because they are used to protect life and property. People use weather forecasts to determine what to wear on a given day or to plan travel or events. Since outdoor activities are severely curtailed by heavy rain, snow and the wind chill, forecasts can be used to plan activities around these events, and to plan ahead and survive them.

SpaceX Falcon Heavy rocket launches powerful hurricane-hunting weather satellite



A SpaceX Falcon Heavy rocket blasts off on the program's 10th flight,

A powerful SpaceX Falcon Heavy rocket boosted a hurricane-hunting GOES weather satellite into orbit Tuesday, the final member of a four-satellite fleet at the heart of an \$11 billion upgrade to the nation's forecasting infrastructure.

"NOAA's geostationary satellites are an indispensable tool for protecting the United States and the one billion people who live and work in the Americas," said Pam Sullivan, GOES program director. "They provide a constant real-time view of weather and dangerous environmental phenomena across the western hemisphere."

A powerful SpaceX Falcon Heavy rocket boosted a hurricane-hunting GOES weather satellite into orbit Tuesday, the final member of a four-satellite fleet at the heart of an \$11 billion upgrade to the nation's forecasting infrastructure.

"NOAA's geostationary satellites are an indispensable tool for protecting the United States and the one billion people who live and work in the Americas," said Pam Sullivan, GOES program director. "They provide a constant real-time view of weather and dangerous environmental phenomena across the western hemisphere."

Appropriately enough, the primary

obstacle to launch of the latest Geostationary Operational Environmental Satellite — GOES-U — was the same sort of weather it was built to observe. Forecasters predicted a 70 percent chance of late afternoon storms that threatened prevent takeoff.

But the expected bad weather took longer to develop than expected, and the Falcon Heavy thundered away from historic pad 39A at the Kennedy Space Center at 5:26 p.m. EDT, propelled by more than 5 million pounds of thrust from the 27 engines at the base of three strapped-together first stage boosters.

After helping push the rocket out of the dense lower atmosphere, the two side boosters fell away and reversed course to fly back to spectacular side-by-side landings at the Cape Canaveral Space Force Station.

A minute-and-a-half after the side boosters separated — four minutes after liftoff — the core stage dropped away, breaking up as planned as it fell to the Atlantic Ocean below.

The single Merlin engine powering the rocket's second stage fired three times over four-and-a-half hours to reach a highly elliptical "transfer" orbit where the GOES satellite was to be released. All three "burns" went off without a hitch, and live video from

the rocket showed the satellite's release from the second stage with the blue-and-white orb of Earth in the distant background.

Renamed GOES-19 once in orbit, the Lockheed Martin-built satellite will have to fire on-board thrusters five times over the next 14 days to circularize its orbit at an altitude of 22,300 miles above the equator where the weather station will circle the globe in lockstep with Earth's rotation, taking 24 hours to complete one orbit. Satellites in such "geosynchronous" orbits appear to hang stationary in the sky, allowing uninterrupted views of the Earth below. Such orbits are used by GOES-type weather satellites, imaging and eavesdropping spy satellites and communications satellites, both military and civilian.

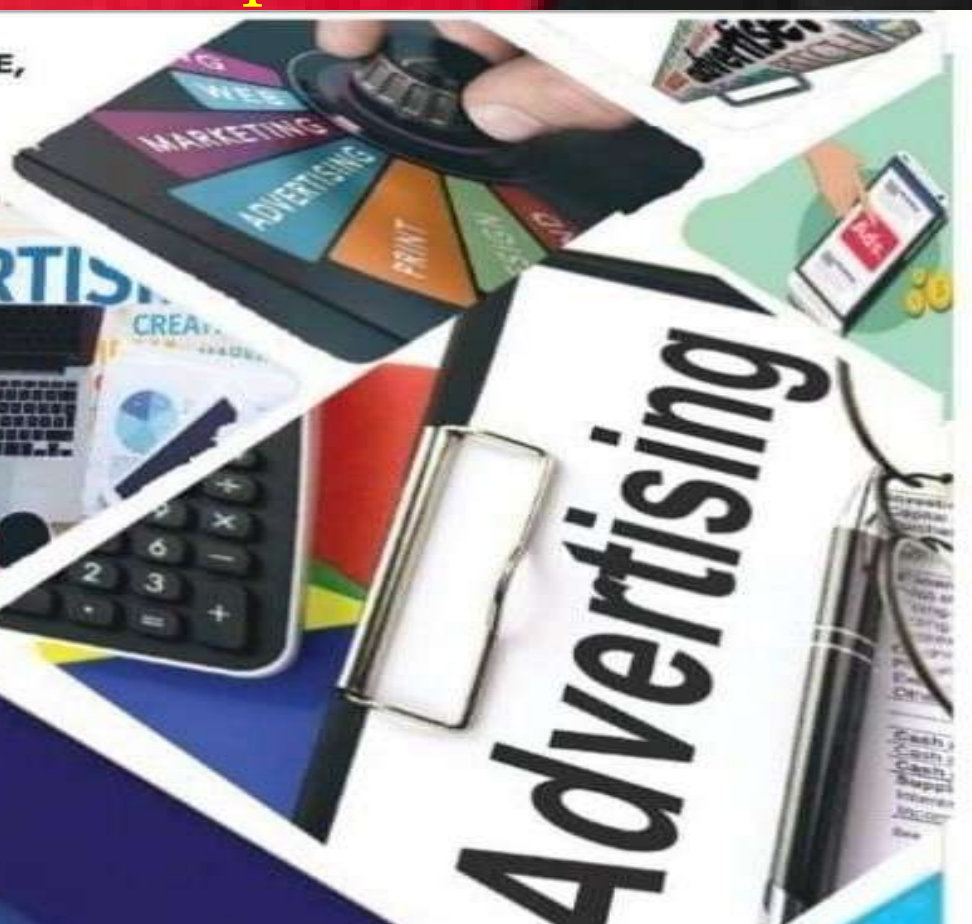

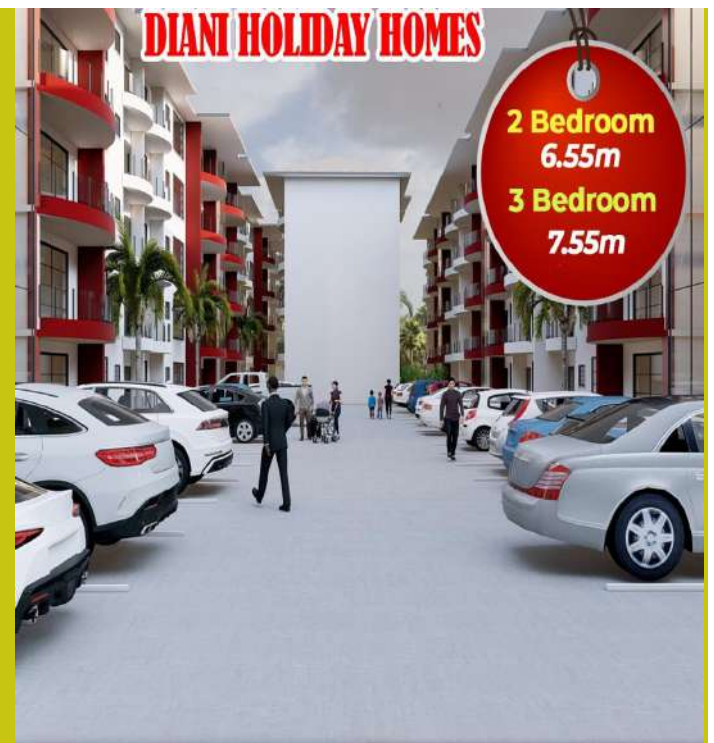
