

Kenyans are angry following the inconsiderate position taken by the government to have a budgetary target of 12% in a country whose GDP growth is at 5.6%.

Kenyans are insisting that we must live within our means.

Raising revenue to meet the targeted percentage means the government will tax us out of existence!

Nothing has changed with the life of an average Kenyan, even after taxing us to our necks through the stipulated allocations of the punitive Finance Act 2023-2024.

The targets were never reached following the massive looting reported by the budget controller. Yet, the government does not show any interest in forcing the citizens to feel like our high taxation, modeled by the government that came to power on a platform of economic projections slated from the bottom up, is to fund the lavish spending of the government that speaks of austerity other than the looting.

People feel that the controversial Finance Act 2023-2024 should run through this year, and Kenyans are now too poor to subject them to further taxation as proposed by the Finance Bill 2024-2025.

A bag of maize from neighboring Uganda would sell in Kenya at Ksh 900, while the same bag from a Kenyan farmer would cost Ksh 3,500



Oregon man who spiked his daughter's friends smoothies with sedatives during sleepover sentenced to 2 years in prison.

n Oregon man who spiked the smoothies of three of his daughter's friends with sedatives last year during a sleepover, ple aded guilty Monday to

multiple felonies and was sentenced to two years in prison, according to court documents and attorneys who oversaw the case.

Michael Meyden, 57, of Lake Oswego, admitted guilt in three counts of causing another person to ingest a controlled substance in Clackamas County Circuit Court, according to prosecutors and one of Meyden's attorneys, Jeff Turnoy.

Clackamas County District Attorney John Wentworth said in a Tuesday statement Meyden deserved time behind bars.

"Mr. Meyden's actions are inexcusable and reckless and required a punishment commensurate with



the crime," he said. "The impact this event has had on the child victims, their families, and our community has been enormous."

Turnoy said on Tuesday, his client could get five months lobbed off his sentence with good behavior. The sentence was part of a negotiated deal with prosecutors that included dismissals of three additional felonies and three misdemeanors charges, authorities said.

Meyden also received three years of post-prison supervision, prosecutors said, adding that the charges that were dropped would not lead to an extended sentence.

Meyden's victims and their relatives were in court Monday, Turnoy said, noting his client was tearfully apolo-

"Mr. Meyden is incredibly remorseful and humbled by his conduct and choices," Turnoy said. "He understands appropriately that he hurt a lot of people and is very regretful of all that. And his demeanor in court was authentic and genuine, showed nothing but sincerity in being apologetic and remorseful for his behavior."

Meyden drugged three of his daughter's friends while they slept over on the night of Aug. 25, 2023, according to court documents and a probable cause affidavit.



He was arrested on the way to the Intercontinental Hotel Nairobi to hold a press conference to announce the formation of the party and was detained without trial on 2 June 1982 and incarcerated at Kamiti and Shimo La Tewa Prisons; Jaramogi was later placed under house arrest in August 1982.

Anyona was also expelled from the ruling party KANU. Shortly after Anyona was detained, his lawyer John Khaminwa was also detained without trial and a crackdown followed that targeted university lecturers, student leaders, politicians, lawyers and journalists. KANU, sensing the danger the two politicians had posed, immediately sought to change the constitution. The result was the passing of a constitutional amendment making Kenya a de facto one-party state the

Anyona was released from detention in 1984 but his attempts to resume active politics were thwarted by the state when he was barred from contesting KANU branch elections in 1985, trade union elections in 1986, the Kitutu East (Masaba) parliamentary seat in the 1988 General Elections and Speaker of the National Assembly in 1988. He teamed up with his friend Jaramogi in 1990 during the clamour for multi-party democracy in Kenya; to many Kenyans, this was one battle Anyona and



Jaramogi could not shy away from because they were the ones who started it in 1982.

Anyona was however arrested at a Nairobi pub and charged with sedition. Others arrested with him included Professor Edward Oyugi, Isiah Ngotho Kariuki, and Augustus Njeru Kathangu. The experiences they went through included torture at the infamous Nyayo House torture chambers in Nairobi. After a marathon trial, they were jailed for fifteen years running concurrently for seven years on charges of scheming to overthrow the Kenyan government and being in possession of seditious and proscribed publications.

According to some documents presented in the trial, it was alleged that Anyona had gone as far as preparing a shadow cabinet to take over after he overthrew the government. However, it was later revealed by an Assistant Minister in the Office of the President, John Keen, that these allegations were nothing but government fabrications, aimed at silencing Anyona. In 1992, after filing

appeals against their sentences, the four were released on bail. On 20 May 1992, they were freed when the state opted not to oppose their appeals.

Multiparty era

With the multi-party elections coming up in December 1992, all opposition parties hoped Anyona would give them his endorsement. FORD-Kenya in particular, then under Jaramogi Oginga Odinga was seen as Anyona's perfect destination. He was elected the FORD-Kenya Nyamira District Branch Chairman in absentia.

In a surprising move how-Anyona ever, rejected FORD-Kenya's overtures, opting instead to launch his own political party Kenya Social Congress. In the 1992 Multi-Party General Elections, he easily won the Kitutu Masaba Constituency parliamentary seat, becoming the only member of parliament from the KSC.

He also stood as a presidential candidate in the same elections and came out 5th. He served as the Chairman of the Public Investments Committee (PIC) of the national assembly for 1993/1994 and was re-elected as a member of parliament in 1997 for another 5-year term.

Anyona died on 4 November 2003 in a car crash on Lusaka Road in Nairobi.

However, one of the jurors questioned whether President Joe Biden's son should have been prosecuted in the first place.

A Delaware woman who was on the jury told ABC News that the case was "a waste of taxpayers' dollars," but in the end, she and her fellow jurors were able to come together with little disagreement.

The 51-year-old juror, who asked not to be identified, said Hunter Biden needed help for his addictions but did not need to receive any prison time for his convic-

"I don't think that anyone who is a nonviolent drug addict should be in prison. Just fine him. We know he did something wrong. Just fine him. He needs help," she said. It took the jury less than a day to come to their decision to convict Hunter Biden of two counts related to false



statements in purchasing the firearm and a count of illegally obtaining a firearm while addicted to drugs.

The juror said politics were not a factor in the decision and the jury worked well, "considering who his father is and the political climate in this country."

"It turned out better than I expected. There was no fighting in the jury room," she

"When we took [the] first vote on count one we were split 50-50, but then when we went down and read each count and you broke it down and you heard each person's opinion, that made sense," the juror plained. "That's why dent's son was on trial.

we found him guilty on all

The key evidence was the text messages between Hunter Biden and others before and following the gun purchase.

"It did show in my opinion that he was trying to get drugs," she said.

The juror said that no other jurors brought up Hunter Biden's addiction or mental health problems during the deliberations.

She reiterated that she felt that Hunter Biden should get help for those issues.

Another juror, who also asked not to be named, told ABC News he was able to put aside the fact that the presi"I knew it, but I didn't take that [into account]," he said. "That didn't affect me or sway me a bit."

Elijah Lewis-Guy, a third juror who spoke to ABC News, said he didn't know who Hunter Biden was before the trial began.

"Him being the son of the president just means that, once again, everyone is human and everyone makes mistakes," he said. "And those mistakes can have serious consequences - not just for them but for everyone else." Lewis-Guy said gun violence claimed the life of his father when he was young and he said prosecutors successfully

showed that Hunter Biden's

drug use prior to the purchase was "too close for me to consider him not a user or addict at that point."

"There [are] too many patterns that I can see that showed that he was using it when he purchased the gun," the juror said.





Smart, 56, was a 22-year-old high school media coordinator when she began an affair with a 15-year-old boy who later fatally shot her husband, Gregory Smart, in Derry, New Hampshire. The shooter was freed in 2015 after serving a 25-year sentence. Though

Pamela Smart denied knowledge of the plot, she was convicted of being an accomplice to first-degree murder and other crimes and sentenced to life without parole.

Smart has been incarcerated for nearly 34 years. In the videotaped statement, she

said she began to "dig deeper into my own responsibility" through her experience in a writing group that "encouraged us to go beyond and to spaces that we didn't want to be in."

"For me, that was really hard, because going into those places, in those spaces is where I found myself responsible for something I desperately didn't want to be responsible for, my husband's murder," she said, her voice quavering. "I had to acknowledge for the first time in my own mind and my own heart how responsible I was, because I had deflected blame all the time, I think, almost as if it was a coping mechanism, because the truth of being so responsible was very difficult for me."

Hamas and Israel Face Pressure to Embrace Cease-Fire Adopted by U.N.

day after the United Nations Security Council endorsed a U.S.-backed cease-fire proposal for the Gaza Strip, the focus shifted on Tuesday to the willingness of Israel and Hamas, under growing international pressure to end the war, to make a deal.

Each side made positive but vague statements about the cease-fire plan and blamed the other for prolonging a war that has devastated Gaza. But neither said it would formally embrace the proposal, which was outlined last month in a speech by President Biden and was the basis of the 14-0 vote in the Security Council on Monday.

Israel has faced growing international criticism for its strategy of systematic destruction in Gaza, at a huge cost in civilian lives. Israeli bombardments and ground offensives in the besieged territory have killed more than 36,000 Palestinians, according to Gaza's Health Ministry, which does not distinguish between combatants and civilians.

An Israeli official who said the Israeli negotiating team had received a copy of Hamas's response described it as a rejection of the proposal that had been presented by Mr. Biden. The Israeli official spoke on the condition of anonymity to discuss the sensitive talks.

Speaking to reporters in Tel Aviv, Mr. Blinken put the onus on Mr. Sinwar, who is thought to be hiding underground in Gaza.

Secretary of State Antony J. Blinken, touring the region for the eighth time since the Hamas-led Oct. 7 assault on Israel, said on Tuesday that the fate of the cease-fire proposal rested with Hamas's top leader in Gaza, Yahya Sinwar.

Husam Badran, a senior Hamas official, countered that Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu of Israel was "the sole obstacle to reaching an agreement that would end the war."

An Israeli government official said in a statement that the proposed deal "enables Israel to achieve" its war goals, including destroy-

ing Hamas's capabilities and freeing all the hostages held in Gaza by Hamas and its allies. But the official, who could be quoted only on that condition that the name and office be withheld, stopped short of saying whether Israel would accept the agreement.

Mr. Netanyahu has repeatedly declined to take a firm stand on the plan. Last week, he sowed doubts when he called the idea of a negotiated permanent cease-fire — which Hamas has called essential — a "nonstarter." Far-right elements of his governing coalition have threatened to bolt if Mr. Netanyahu accepts a cease-fire,

potentially toppling him from power.

Yet the Biden administration insists not only that Israel has endorsed the proposal, but that it was also Israel's plan to begin with. Mr. Blinken said he had received explicit assurances from Mr. Netanyahu in their meeting on Monday that he supported the proposal, suggesting that the prime minister was saying one thing to the United States and another to his coalition partners.

Hamas and an allied group, Palestinian Islamic Jihad, issued a statement late on Tuesday saying they had given Egypt and Qatar a response to the U.N. resolution, but did not say they had accepted it. They stressed their readiness to negotiate and their demand for an Israeli withdrawal — points they had made many times before. Qatar and Egypt act as intermediaries between Israel and Hamas, which do not communicate directly with each other.






Temperature, rain, snow, fog and wind are all part of weather. Severe weather events such as tornadoes, tropical storms, hurricanes, cyclones, floods, lightning strikes and extreme weather affect us all. In addition to weather forecasts are ozone levels, changing climate conditions and solar winds. Weather warnings are important forecasts because they are used to protect life and property. People use weather forecasts to determine what to wear on a given day or to plan travel or events. Since outdoor activities are severely curtailed by heavy rain, snow and the wind chill, forecasts can be used to plan activities around these events, and to plan ahead and

eastern half of the United States faces an inheat tense wave starting late this week and peaking next week that could produce dangerously high temperatures over a large area for an extended period. It could threaten records and place vulnerable groups of people at risk from heat-related illnesses. Over the weekend, wide-

spread highs in the mid-90s to around 100 — some 10 to 20 degrees above normal — will spread across the southern Plains, South and Midwest. By Monday, the heat will swell into the Ohio Valley before reaching the Mid-Atlantic and Northeast shortly thereafter.

For much of next week, a punishing combination of heat and humidity will remain lodged over the East although some relief

may arrive in the Upper Midwest during its second

The source of the heat is a sprawling heat dome — or strong zone of high pressure — that is centered over northern Mexico and the southwest United States, where record high temperatures are occurring in some areas. It is forecast to shift eastward this weekend and will become centered over the southeast. Next week it will drift northward toward the Mid-Atlantic while strengthening and expanding in all directions. Some models indicate that the heat dome could reach historic strength for the time of year. The European weather model simulation, shown above, shows its intensity even surpassing the heat dome of June 29, 2012, during which Washington set a June record of 104 degrees. It hit 109 degrees in Nashville and

105 in Raleigh, N.C., that same day.

It's already been one of the warmest years on record in the East because of a largely absent winter and mild spring. But since the start of June, the nation's most extreme heat has occupied the West. That's about to change in a big way. While the heat dome shifts and reconfigures over the South and southeast, the potential for record highs will arrive as soon as Friday in Atlanta and Raleigh, where temperatures could rise to near 100. Over the weekend, record highs near and above 100 should be common from Arkansas to coastal Georgia. As the heat dome shifts north and strengthens, record highs are probable across the Ohio Valley on Monday and into the Mid-Atlantic by Tuesday. More record heat is probable in the East after that,

The National Weather Service has developed a new HeatRisk product, which evaluates the threat of predicted temperatures on a 0 to 4 scale. Most of the Lower 48 states will experience at least Level 2 or 3 HeatRisk levels over the next week as the heat dome evolves. Large areas of Missouri, Illinois and Indiana as well as portions of Kansas, Iowa, Michigan, Ohio, West Virginia and Georgia are forecast to experience Level 4 or "extreme" conditions. Des Moines, St. Louis, Chicago, Indianapolis and Atlanta are some of the cities in this zone. Washington Post Share
