Montgomery church to hold re-enactment of Frederick Douglass' speech

'What To The Slave Is The Fourth Of July?' "Knowledge unfits a child to be a slave."



"I prefer to be true to myself, even at the hazard of incurring the ridicule of others, rather than to be false, and to incur my own abhorrence."

This Saturday, after the Fourth of July, church members and community leaders will gather in Montgomery to read the famous Frederick Douglass speech.

The address titled "What to the slave is the Fourth of July?" focuses on the hypocrisy of America celebrating its freedom while hundreds of African Americans remained enslaved and in bondage. America celebrated Independence Day in 1776. Slavery wasn't abolished in the United States until 1865.

"In Frederick Douglass' speech, he talked about 'how can America be free when its people are not?' He talked about inequality and civil rights, so we wanted to do this re-enactment and discuss afterward," said Old Ship AME Zion Church's Reverend Kathy McFadden.

This partnership is with the Alabama African American Civil Rights Heritage Sites Consortium. The re-enactment and panel discussion are happening at Old Ship AME Zion Church in Montgomery, one of the oldest Black churches in the area. Pas-

tors and civil rights activists will be participating in the panel discussion.

"We thought it would be good to do a re-enactment, but more importantly have a discussion afterward as a way of educating people about the speech, but also to talk about what's going now. That was 172 years ago and we're still fighting with some of the same stuff," Rev. McFadden said. Awareness share.(WSFA) More excerpts on page 17

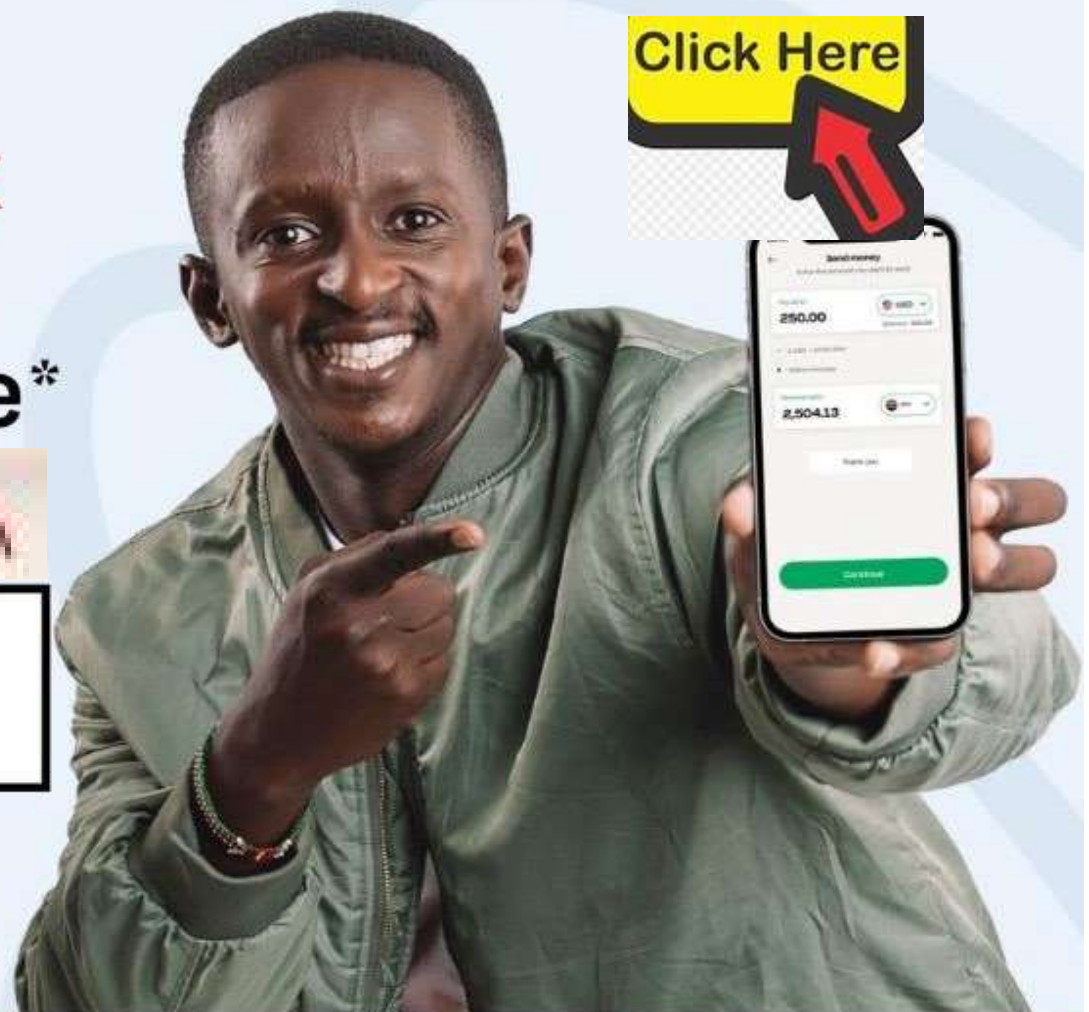

Is the legitimacy of President Ruto As The Head of State And Government- Now Questionable?

The recent invasion of Parliament by protestors following the institution's validation of a hiked taxation in the Finance Bill in contradiction to the people's will now raises the question of the legitimacy of the president as the Head of State and government.

The president went against the will of the very people he should listen to by projecting support for a tax hike aimed at raising \$ 2.7m through revenue taxes.

At the height of the disagreements between the people and the government, protestors overwhelmed the security. They invaded Parliament, forcing the legislators to flee through an underground tunnel to their basement parking, where the Speakers of the Assembly were the first to be evacuated utilizing ambulances, leaving the rest of the parliamentarians at the mercy of the prevailing protestors as they torched the institution.

The world is now discussing both the presidency and legislature, under the circumstances of which the two institutions having undergone such levels of eroded trust, how can they redeem their face.

In some parts of the world, the president should have resigned and Parliament dissolved!

The president did not only concede by rejecting the proposed Financial Act as forced by the Gen Z who led in Kenya's #RejectFinanceBill protestations, but also agreed to abide by a raft of changes demanded from the government.

Among the issues pointed out are the offices of the First and Second Ladies to be scrapped off.

A collection of Ksh 1.3 b was being direc-



ted to the two offices that Gen Z proposed to have the monies redirected to sustain the Linda Mama program initiated by the fourth regime to support pregnant women through their delivery.

The CAS is also on the list of those that the government has to scrap off together with the office of the Chief Minister, which are all unconstitutional.

There is a need to have a lean government, and going by that, the current Cabinet Secretaries' slots are twenty-one or there about, and the proposal is to be reduced to about fourteen.

Permanent Secretaries are at fifty one or there about. The proposal is to have them reduced to about thirty.

The IEBC has also featured in the Gen Z proposals, and as a matter of grave concern, its constitution has been called for within the next thirty days!

Given the circumstances herein, Parliament was taken, and since power belongs to the people, Parliament should be dissolved and seek a fresh mandate.

It is also inaccurate for Charlene Ruto to come forward in the prevailing circumstances as a Gen Z leader.

Her notions as a first daughter are things Kenyans want to be wished away from the vicinity.

In her recent speech as head of a group of a Gen Z collection, she lectured Kenyans

on dialogue as a way to peace, ending the prevailing hostilities.

Charlene Ruto talking about peace without first acknowledging the deaths that have occurred is a position that has been taken by the first family of showing no empathy to the families of those who lost their loved ones in the hands of police brutality!

The first daughter should know that Kenyans are disgusted with the first family, so she should refrain from talking to the public or giving any views until those affected heal completely.

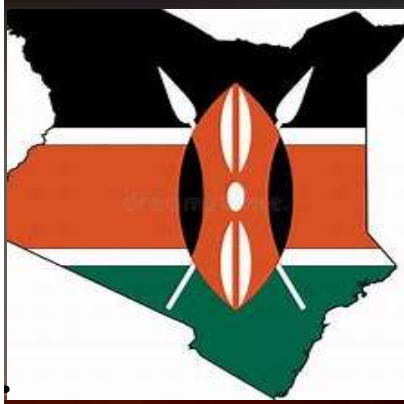

Rest In Peace

Dr. Zachary T. Onyonka (1939–1996) was a Kenyan politician. Onyonka was the foreign minister from 1969 to 1996 under several other ministries up to and including Education, Economic Planning & Development and Trade and Foreign Affairs. Well Known within the Kisii community, he was always at loggerheads with then Nyaribari Chache MP Simeon Nyachae until he died. Onyonka was elected to parliament in the 1969 elections from Kitutu West Constituency when he trounced the first cabinet minister from Kisii, Lawrence Sagini Ndemo. He was the youngest MP at about 25 years. He retained his parliamentary seat until his death. He was famous for leading an anti-Nyachae crusade in Kisii after he was released from Kodiaga prison in Kisumu.

He had been arrested and charged with murder following a fatal shooting incident involving his bodyguards and a voter in then Kitutu West constituency campaigns. Ouru Ndege was shot dead after he attempted to attack Dr. Onyonka with a knife during the stormy 1983 campaigns along Kisii-Migori road junction.

His rival, John Bosco Mboga had just addressed his supporters in the area and when Onyonka, who was a cabinet minister in President Moi's government arrived, Ndege attempted to stab him with a sword leading to the minister's bodyguards shooting him to death.

Onyonka and his guards did not have a car at the time of the shooting. He was rescued by a matatu driver, Joseph

Moya Nyambariga, from Botori area in Bomorenda, Bonchari, who drove the sieged minister in his matatu, christened Bolingo Na Ngai Express to safety at Suneka Chief's camp.

He was arrested soon after and locked up in Kisumu awaiting trial on murder charges. The prosecution was unable to prove the case against him and in 1984, Onyonka was set free. He had won the hotly contested election in absentia and after two years in the cold, Moi appointed him Minister for Foreign Affairs.

Before the 1988 elections, Onyonka led a group of politicians from Kisii dubbed the Four Os. This stands for Onyonka, Obure (Chris from Bobasi) Omanga (Andrew from Nyaribari Chache) and Onyancha (David from West Mugirango) to launch the famous "Kebirigo Declaration" in which Nyachae was denounced.

The Kebirigo declaration was a strong political ideology that stood for independence of each constituency in Kisii against manipulation from Nyachae. At that time, it had become increasingly evident that Nyachae who was a powerful civil servant was planning to plunge into active politics. Onyonka alleged that Nyachae had embarked on a series of secret campaigns, recruiting candidates against incumbent MPs so that he could make it to parliament with a clean slate of leaders, if he was cleared by KANU to run for elective seat.

The Kebirigo declaration was therefore meant to assert the authority and legitimacy of each member of parliament from Kisii and also sought to reject the political dominion from Nyaribari, Nyachae's home constituency.

After Onyonka's death in 1996, he was succeeded by

Jimmy Nuru Angwenyi as MP for Kitutu Chache. His son Richard Momoima Onyonka, later dethroned Angwenyi to become the area MP. After the 2013 electoral review, Kitutu Chache was divided into two constituencies, North and South (Mosocho).

Dr. Zachary Onyonka was a political titan whose influence among the Kisii community was only rivalled by the late Nyaribari Chache MP Simeon Nyachae. He served the people of Kitutu Chache as their member of parliament for over twenty years. The politician goes down in the history books as the first Kisii man to earn a PhD. He was also the first MP to win a political seat in absentia.

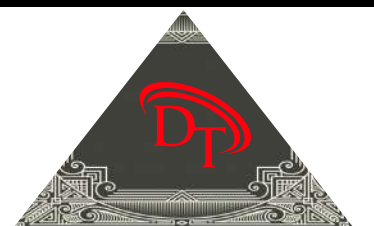
Sensing that the minister was in real danger, security guards shot dead the opponent causing fracas that lasted for hours.

With the minister operating without vehicle, a Matatu driver, Joseph Nyambariga, evacuated Onyonka who would later be arrested and charged with murder at Kodiaga prison.

During the polls, Onyonka won by landslide and would later take the position in parliament after he was acquitted.

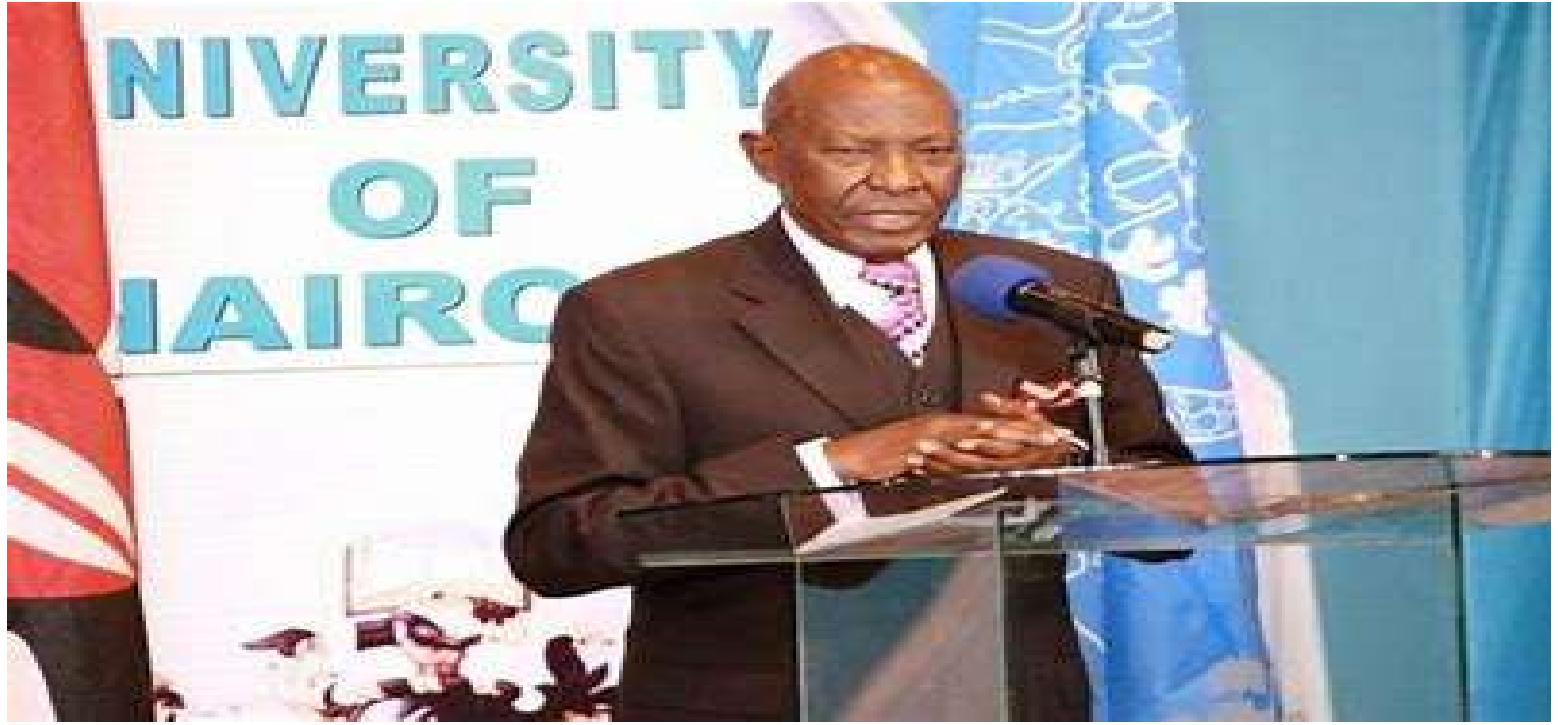

DEATH OF A LEGEND: JOE WANJUI WAS A TRUE INDUSTRIALIST.

Billionaire Joe Wanjui is dead. When we were small kids, on hearing his name, we used to be told that he was the owner of the East African Industries (EAI), the forerunner to Unilever Kenya. Those guys used to manufacture nearly everything we saw at home; Kimbo, Vaseline, Closeup, Omo, Elianto....the works.

I'm often amazed by how great people in this country die quietly and their stories fade off like that. There are things people do not know about Wanjui. Apart from the fact that at some point, he was the Chairman of the DP Council of Elders, the moneyed Kikuyu businessmen who funded Mwai Kibaki and his party. But after the 2002 elections, when Kibaki's surrogates brought back tribalism by the truckloads and shut out the other communities, Wanjui was the powerful insider voice who constantly called Kibaki to order and demanded that the government be run in a way that sustained not only lasting peace, but an environment conducive for business and thrift. He also frowned on the contempt and hubris exhibited by the new Mount Kenya power brokers under Kibaki.

But I pay tribute to Joe Wanjui for two main reasons...

One, and especially in the current Kenyan circumstances, he was one of the last among a breed of Kenyan billionaires who actually MANUFACTURED SOMETHING to make money, a far cry from the modern Kenyan quick-fix billionaires who amass wealth through "ni God manze". This fact is important in determining the stark contrast between Kikuyu Entitlement and Kalenjin Incompetence. The Kikuyu old money networks built lasting money through industry. Even those alleged to have stolen money from government ran thriving private industrial concerns and left the government parastatals alive. Their Kalenjin counterparts under both Moi and Ruto would wake up and become billionaires overnight, leaving dust where previously a state enterprise stood.

Because people of Wanjui's ilk knew the value of wealth and its sustainabi-

lity, they didn't go around carrying money in sacks at harambees, or tapping their feet like illiterate penguins, to illustrate the count by each million. Certainly, this group wouldn't don watches of 20m, because those who make money genuinely don't tie it to an asset around a wrist. Amidst the Gen Z protests, perhaps we need to take a step back and ask what the new Kalenjin power brokers around Ruto, and their fraudulent friends like @DidmusWaBarasa, have done to buy helicopters overnight. Because Joe Wanjui and his peers showed us that the credible way to create wealth was to first create a going concern, build it and employ people. But the Sudis of our time have turned this philosophy upside down.

The second and bigger reason I celebrate Joe Wanjui happened during interesting times.

At the peak of the fallout in the Kibaki regime in 2005, when the LDP wing, and especially the Luo community, had all but bid farewell to the NARC-Rainbow coalition, the vacancy for Vice Chancellor at the

University of Nairobi came up for filling. Part of the reforms brought by the Narc government was that unlike previous times, when the VC was appointed by the President, this was going to be the very first time a VC was being competitively interviewed. You should have seen the top scholars, foreigners from Europe, America, South Africa, Asia and the Middle East, who all wanted the job, arriving at JKIA for the interview. Joe Wanjui was then the Chancellor of the UoN, again the first time the President of the Republic wasn't the one. He would chair the interviews.

At the end, three scholars were short-listed. Prof Jacob Kaimenyi, a Meru. Prof James Kimani, a Kikuyu. Prof George Albert Omoro Magoha, a Luo. The very powerful Merus in government; Muthaura, Mwiraria and Kiraitu Murungi, wanted Kaimenyi as VC. The very powerful Kikuyus, led by Chris Murungaru, Stanley Murage and John Michuki, wanted Kimani. Chancellor Wanjui decided to call a press conference. Stretching his hand for illustration, he said "Prof Magoha's

CV is thiiiiis long! He has emerged the best and will get the job. He knows he has to perform in this job, but he deserves the appointment".

Wanjui was aware that if he didn't announce this publicly, Magoha, who had by then been known in many circles as a sort of Luo supremacist, would never get the job. But as Chancellor and a man who had managed some of the biggest industries in Kenya, he also knew that if he didn't appoint the best VC for his university, he would stare into decline and tribalism at the premier institution. With that, he left the powerful government forces who wanted their tribesmen to go and screw a mango. Watching this presser, I promised myself that I would respect Joe Wanjui forever. Because there were few men who could stand up for principles and moral probity like he did that day. As he stood up, he said to Prof Magoha, "Go out and undertake your duties without fear or favour". And Magoha did.

You won't find such fine men today. And it's a shame.

Talk of Kamala Harris replacing Joe Biden surges as White House calls her 'the future'

The bottom line is this, let us not decide who is going to be the president of the United States based on the 90-minute debate,'

Chatter around Vice President Kamala Harris has surged amid steadily increasing calls for President Joe Biden to withdraw from the 2024 race following his debate debacle.

Harris' name is circulating the political and online realms at the highest level in years, and that was exacerbated on Wednesday afternoon with a remark from a White House briefing room.

A reporter brought up Biden in 2020 referring to himself as a 'transition' candidate and bridge to the next generation of Democratic leaders, and asked White House press secretary Karine Jean-Pierre if he still believes that.

Jean-Pierre in her answer referred to Harris as 'president'.

'One of the reasons why he picked the vice president, President (sic) Kamala Harris, is because she is indeed the future of the party,' she said during her regular press briefing.

And he's very proud to have partnered with her and continue to partner with her.'

Jean-Pierre went on to say that Biden, 81, and Harris, 59, are 'ready to go' and 'ready to

continue' in the months leading up to the November election.

She sought to dispell rumors that Biden could be dropping out of the race hours after one of his key allies reportedly said 'he knows if he has two more events like' the disastrous debate, that he may not be able to salvage his reelection campaign.

And as Americans continue to doubt Biden's fitness to seek another term, Democratic House Minority Leader Hakeem Jeffries has told lawmakers that Harris would be the best alternative to Biden

if he decides to withdraw, two sources told The Washington Post on Wednesday.

But Biden on the same day insisted that he is still fully charging forward.

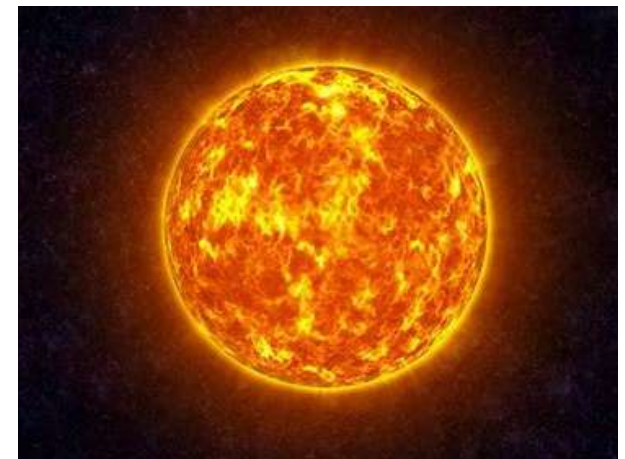
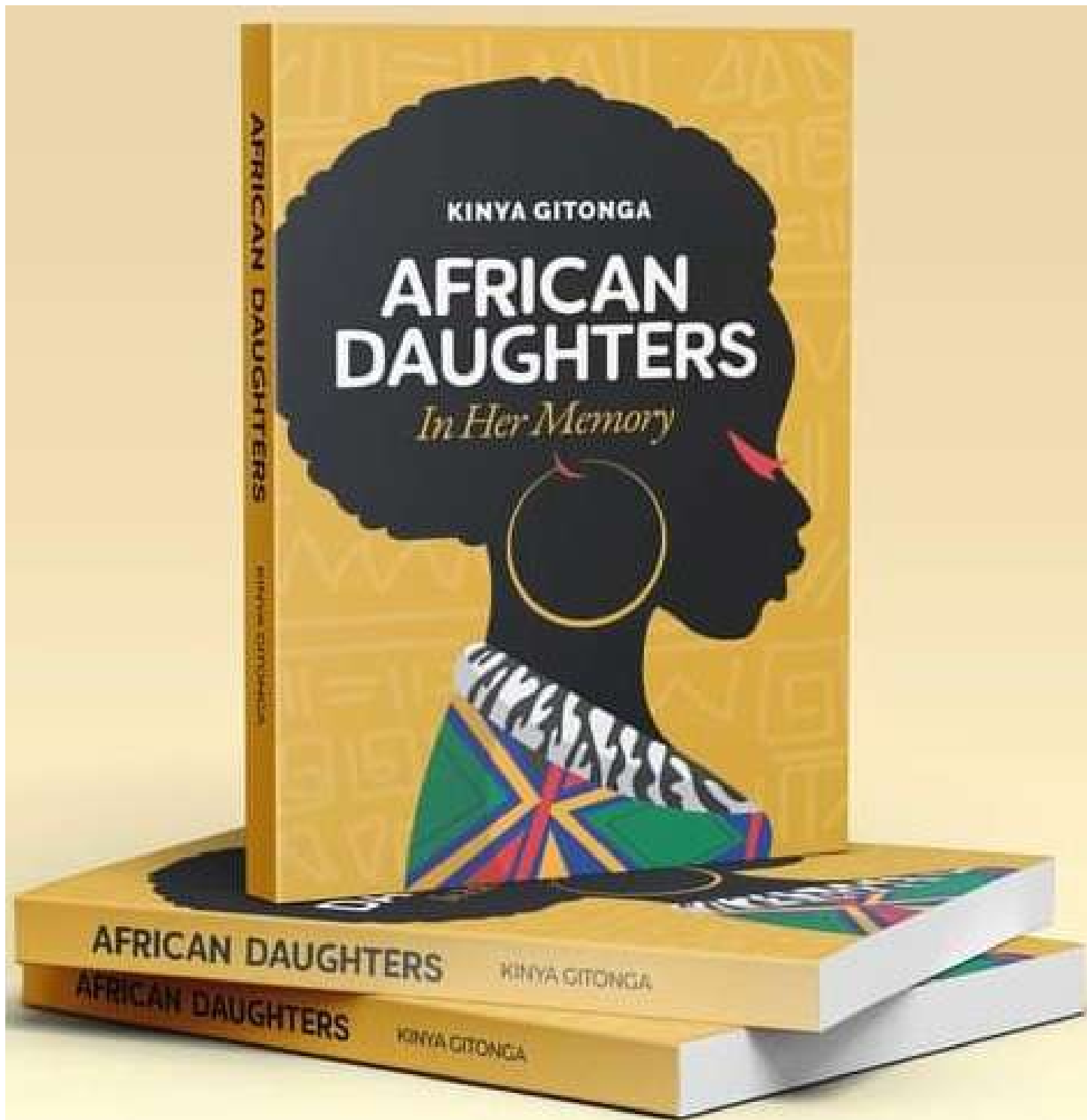

Israel, Hezbollah trade fire after strike kills commander in Lebanon.

The clashes have also sparked an exodus, forcing tens of thousands of people in both northern Israel and southern Lebanon to flee their homes across the border region.

Fear of a possible full-scale war between Israel and the Hamas-allied militant group Hezbollah in Lebanon was stoked Thursday after an Israeli airstrike killed a senior Hezbollah commander. Israel said the commander it killed Wednesday, Mohammad Naameh Nasser, was responsible for firing rockets into Israel. Hezbollah — a group which, like Hamas, is backed by Iran but believed to be larger and much better armed — responded with another barrage of rocket fire. Hezbollah has stepped up its attacks since Israel, which shares its northern border with Leba-



non, launched the war in Gaza in response to Hamas' Oct. 7 terrorist attack. Hezbollah has said it won't stop firing rockets at Israel until there's a cease-fire in Gaza. The Israel Defense Forces said it intercepted drones and other

projectiles fired from southern Lebanon on Thursday and that some of the falling debris caused fires on the ground. The military did not report any casualties, but said it was responding to the Hezbollah fire by "striking launch posts in southern Lebanon."

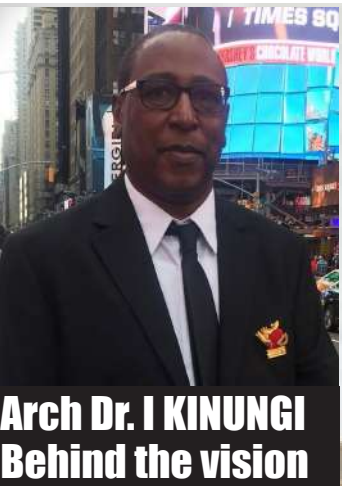
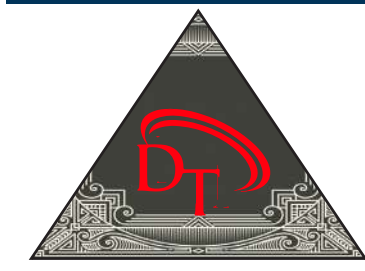
The escalating exchange of fire across the border has been deadly. The Lebanese Health Ministry reported at least 435 deaths on that side of the border as of June 26. About 90 of those killed by Israeli shelling have been civilians, according to the Al Jazeera network. In Israel at least 27 people have been killed by Hezbollah rocket and drone attacks since October, including 10 civilians, according to previous statements by Israeli authorities.

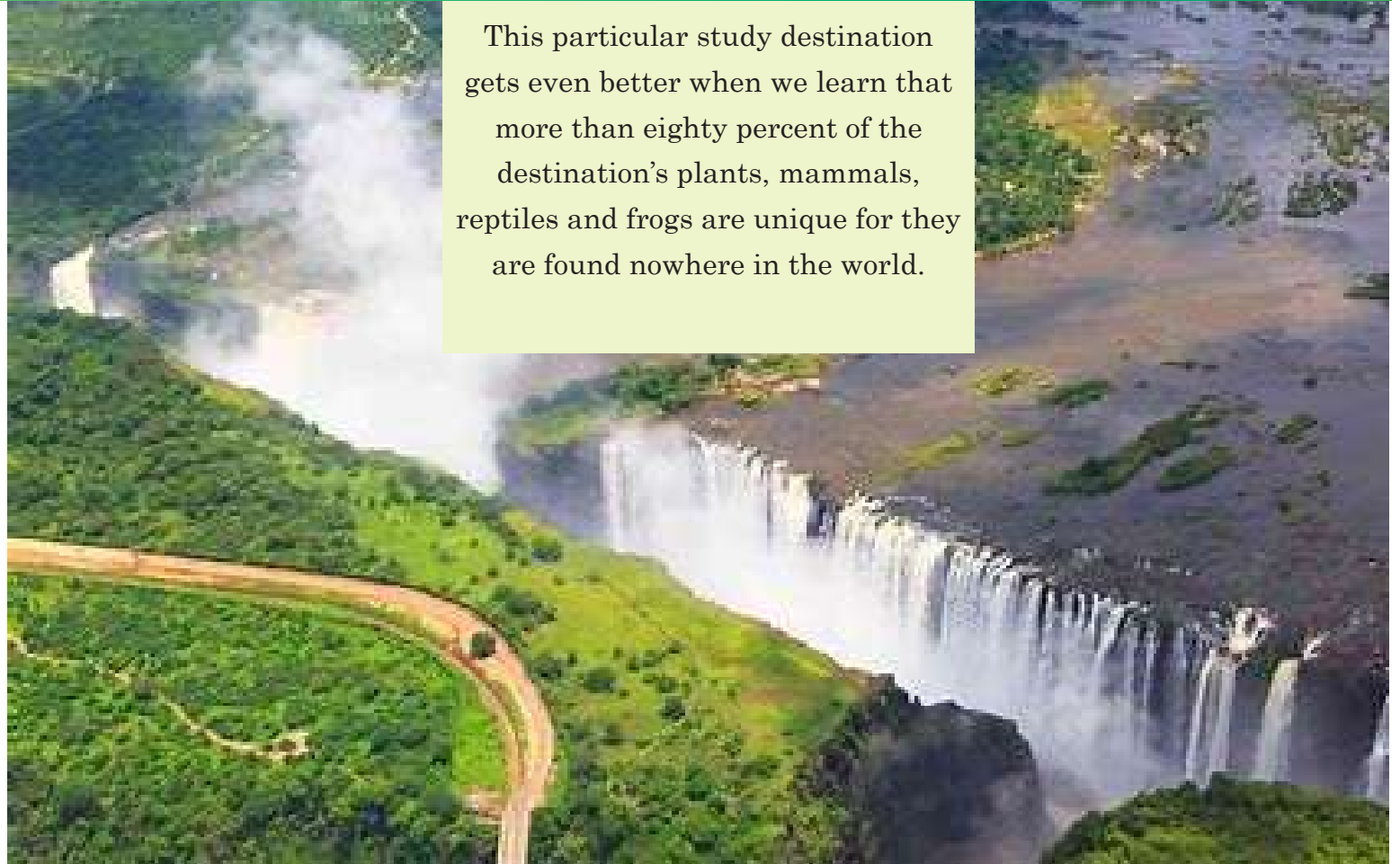

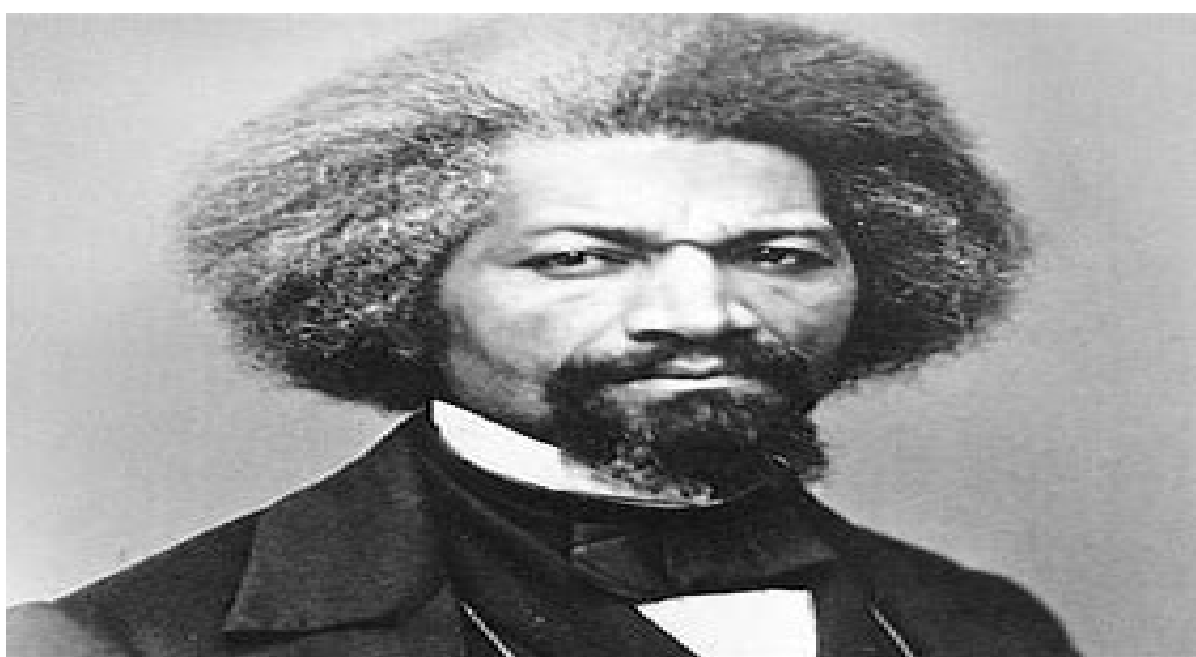

What to the Slave Is the Fourth of July?

HE who could address this audience without a quailing sensation, has stronger nerves than I have. I do not remember ever to have appeared as a speaker before any assembly more shrinkingly, nor with greater distrust of my ability, than I do this day. A feeling has crept over me, quite unfavorable to the exercise of my limited powers of speech. The task before me is one which requires much previous thought and study for its proper performance. I know that apologies of this sort are generally considered flat and unmeaning. I trust, however, that mine will not be so considered. Should I seem at ease, my appearance would much misrepresent me. The



little experience I have had in addressing public meetings, in country school houses, avails me nothing on the present occasion.

The papers and placards say, that I am to deliver a 4th July oration. This certainly, sounds large, and out of the common way, for me. It is true that I have often had the privilege to speak in this beautiful Hall, and to address many who now honor me with their presence. But neither their familiar faces, nor the perfect gage I think I have of Corinthian Hall, seems to free me from embarrassment.

The fact is, ladies and gentlemen, the distance between this platform and the slave plantation, from which I escaped, is considerable—and the difficulties to be overcome in getting from the latter to the former, are by no means slight. That I am here to-day, is, to me, a

matter of astonishment as well as of gratitude. You will not, therefore, be surprised, if in what I have to say, I evince no elaborate preparation, nor grace my speech with any high sounding exordium. With little experience and with less learning, I have been able to throw my thoughts hastily and imperfectly together; and trusting to your patient and generous indulgence, I will proceed to lay them before you.

This, for the purpose of this celebration, is the 4th of July. It is the birthday of your National Independence, and of your political freedom. This, to you, is what the Passover was to the emancipated people of God. It carries your minds back to the day, and to the act of your great deliverance; and to the signs, and to the wonders, associated with that act that day. This celebration also marks the beginning of another year of your

national life; and reminds you that the Republic of America is now 76 years old. I am glad, fellow-citizens, that your nation is so young. Seventy-six years, though a good old age for a man, is but a mere speck in the life of a nation. "Three score years and ten is the allotted time for individual men; but nations number their years by thousands. According to this fact, you are, even now only in the beginning of you national career, still lingering in the period of childhood. I repeat, I am glad this is so. There is hope in the thought, and hope is much needed, under the dark clouds which lower above the horizon.

The eye of the reformer is met with angry flashes, portending disastrous times; but his heart may well beat lighter at the thought that America is young, and that she is still in the impressive stage of her existence. May

he not hope that high lessons of wisdom, of justice and of truth, will yet give direction to her destiny? Were the nation older, the patriot's heart might be sadder, and the reformer's brow heavier. Its future might be shrouded in gloom, and the hope of its prophets go out in sorrow. There is consolation in the thought, that America is young.—Great streams are not easily turned from channels, worn deep in the course of ages. They may sometimes rise in quiet and stately majesty, and inundate the land, refreshing and fertilizing the earth with their mysterious properties. They may also rise in wrath and fury, and bear away, on their angry waves, the accumulated wealth of years of toil and hardship. They, however, gradually flow back to the same old channel, and flow on as serenely as ever. But, while the river may not be turned aside, it may dry up, and leave nothing behind but the withered branch, and the unsightly rock, to howl in the abyss-sweeping wind, the sad tale of departed glory. Fellow-citizens, I shall not presume to dwell at length on the associations that cluster about this day. 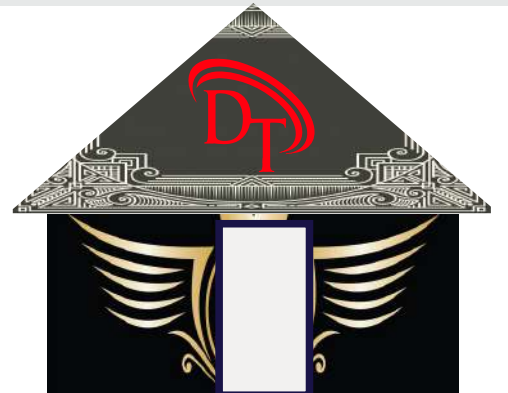

Symptoms
Signs and symptoms of mental illness can vary, depending on the disorder, circumstances and other factors. Mental illness symptoms can affect emotions, thoughts and behaviors. Examples of signs and symptoms include:
Feeling sad or down
Confused thinking or reduced ability to concentrate
Excessive fears or worries, or extreme feelings of guilt
Extreme mood changes of highs and lows

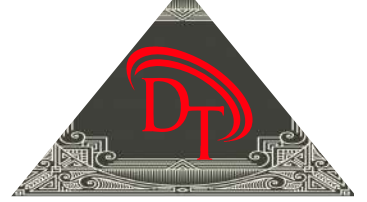
Withdrawal from friends and activities
Significant tiredness, low energy or problems sleeping
Detachment from reality (delusions), paranoia or hallucinations
Inability to cope with daily problems or stress
Trouble understanding and relating to situations and to people
Problems with alcohol or drug use

Excessive anger, hostility or violence
Suicidal thinking
Sometimes symptoms of a mental health disorder appear as physical problems, such as stomach pain, back

pain, headaches, or other unexplained aches and pains.
When to see a doctor
If you have any signs or symptoms of a mental illness, see your primary care provider or a mental health professional. Most mental illnesses don't improve on their own, and if untreated, a mental illness may get worse over time and cause serious problems.



Mental illnesses, in general, are thought to be caused by a variety of genetic and environmental factors:
Inherited traits. Mental illness is more common in people whose blood relatives also have a mental illness. Certain genes may increase your risk of developing a mental illness, and your life situation may trigger it.
Environmental exposures before birth. Exposure to environmental stressors, inflammatory conditions, toxins, alcohol or drugs while in the womb can sometimes be linked to mental illness.
Brain chemistry. Neurotransmitters are naturally occurring brain chemicals that carry signals to other parts of your brain and body. When the neural networks involving these chemicals are impaired, the function of nerve receptors and nerve systems change, leading to depression and other emotional disorders.

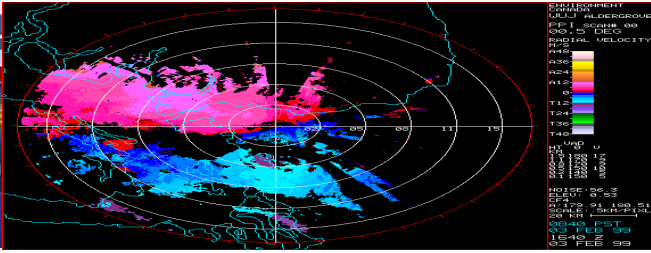

Temperature, rain, snow, fog and wind are all part of weather. Severe weather events such as tornadoes, tropical storms, hurricanes, cyclones, floods, lightning strikes and extreme weather affect us all. In addition to weather forecasts are ozone levels, changing climate conditions and solar winds. Weather warnings are important forecasts because they are used to protect life and property. People use weather forecasts to determine what to wear on a given day or to plan travel or events. Since outdoor activities are severely curtailed by heavy rain, snow and the wind chill, forecasts can be used to plan activities around these events, and to plan ahead and survive them.

SpaceX Falcon Heavy rocket launches powerful hurricane-hunting weather satellite



A SpaceX Falcon Heavy rocket blasts off on the program's 10th flight,

A powerful SpaceX Falcon Heavy rocket boosted a hurricane-hunting GOES weather satellite into orbit Tuesday, the final member of a four-satellite fleet at the heart of an \$11 billion upgrade to the nation's forecasting infrastructure.

"NOAA's geostationary satellites are an indispensable tool for protecting the United States and the one billion people who live and work in the Americas," said Pam Sullivan, GOES program director. "They provide a constant real-time view of weather and dangerous environmental phenomena across the western hemisphere."

A powerful SpaceX Falcon Heavy rocket boosted a hurricane-hunting GOES weather satellite into orbit Tuesday, the final member of a four-satellite fleet at the heart of an \$11 billion upgrade to the nation's forecasting infrastructure.

"NOAA's geostationary satellites are an indispensable tool for protecting the United States and the one billion people who live and work in the Americas," said Pam Sullivan, GOES program director. "They provide a constant real-time view of weather and dangerous environmental phenomena across the western hemisphere."

Appropriately enough, the primary

obstacle to launch of the latest Geostationary Operational Environmental Satellite — GOES-U — was the same sort of weather it was built to observe. Forecasters predicted a 70 percent chance of late afternoon storms that threatened prevent takeoff.

But the expected bad weather took longer to develop than expected, and the Falcon Heavy thundered away from historic pad 39A at the Kennedy Space Center at 5:26 p.m. EDT, propelled by more than 5 million pounds of thrust from the 27 engines at the base of three strapped-together first stage boosters.

After helping push the rocket out of the dense lower atmosphere, the two side boosters fell away and reversed course to fly back to spectacular side-by-side landings at the Cape Canaveral Space Force Station.

A minute-and-a-half after the side boosters separated — four minutes after liftoff — the core stage dropped away, breaking up as planned as it fell to the Atlantic Ocean below.

The single Merlin engine powering the rocket's second stage fired three times over four-and-a-half hours to reach a highly elliptical "transfer" orbit where the GOES satellite was to be released. All three "burns" went off without a hitch, and live video from

the rocket showed the satellite's release from the second stage with the blue-and-white orb of Earth in the distant background.

Renamed GOES-19 once in orbit, the Lockheed Martin-built satellite will have to fire on-board thrusters five times over the next 14 days to circularize its orbit at an altitude of 22,300 miles above the equator where the weather station will circle the globe in lockstep with Earth's rotation, taking 24 hours to complete one orbit. Satellites in such "geosynchronous" orbits appear to hang stationary in the sky, allowing uninterrupted views of the Earth below. Such orbits are used by GOES-type weather satellites, imaging and eavesdropping spy satellites and communications satellites, both military and civilian.

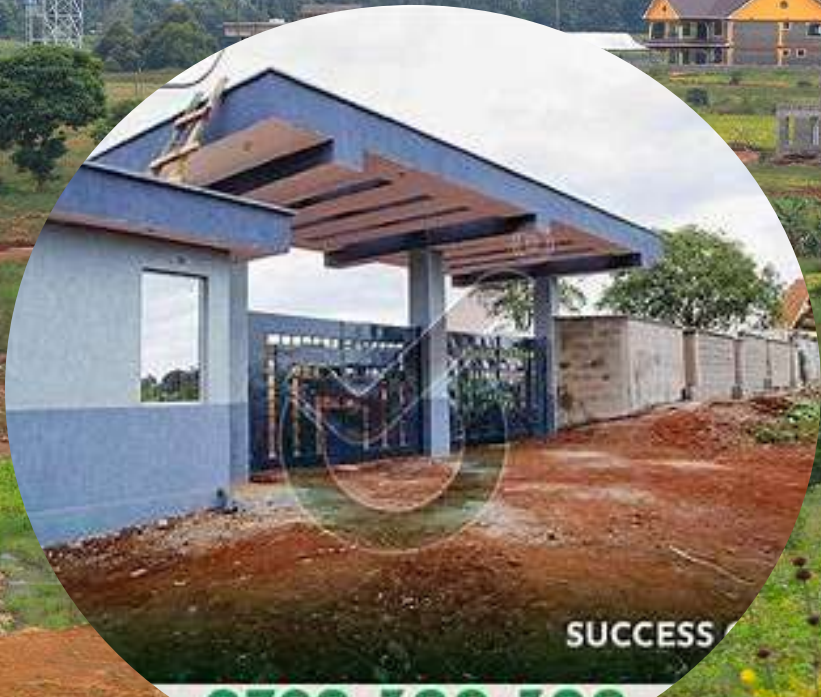

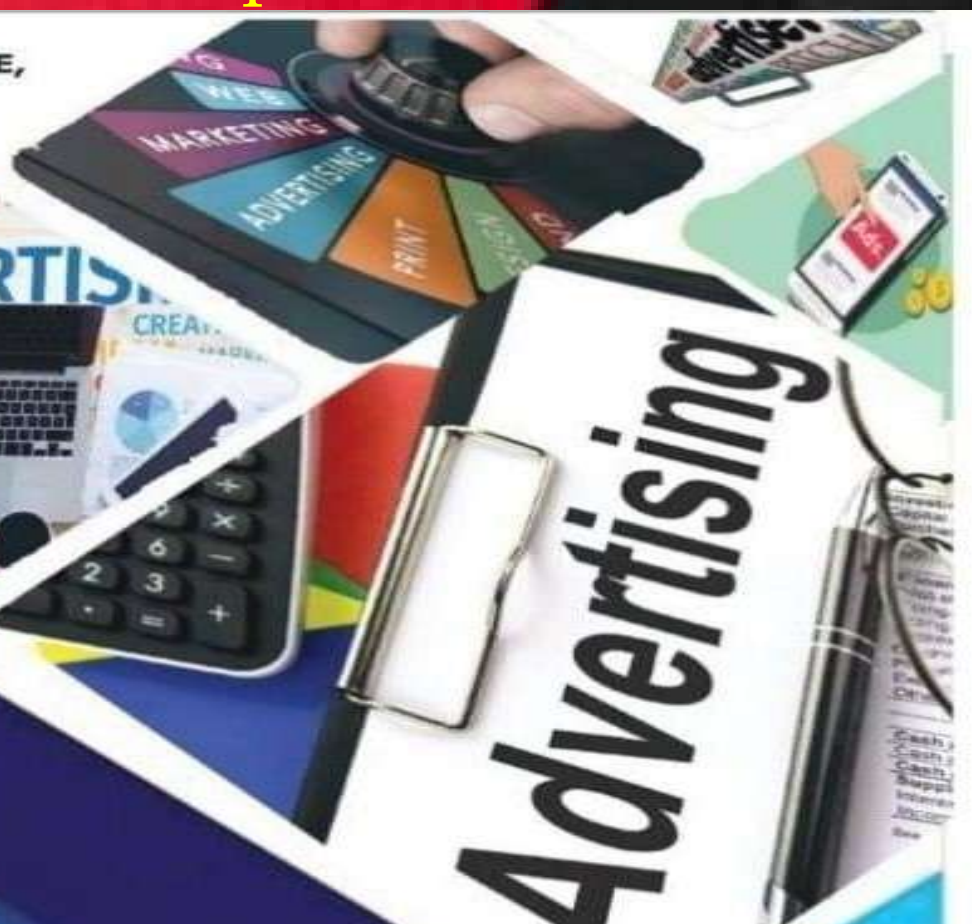

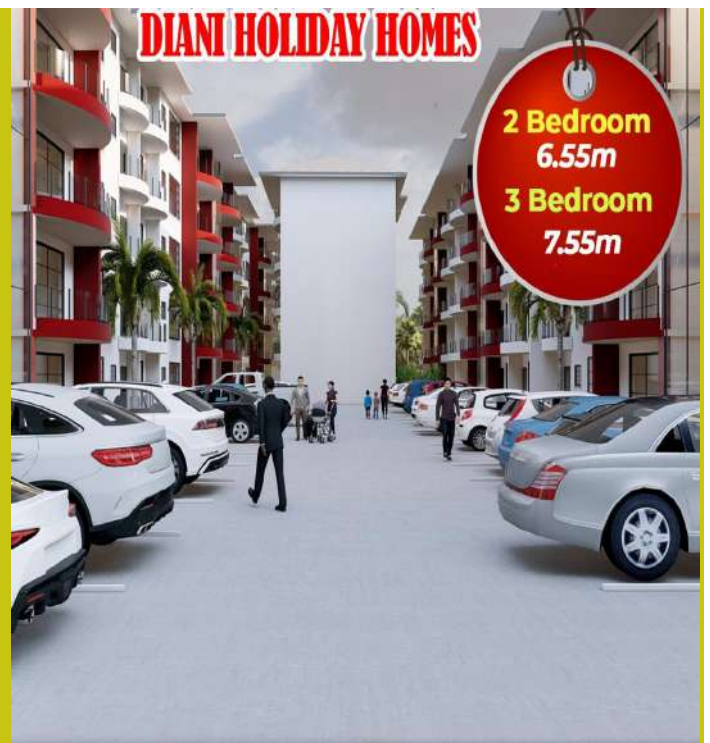

Bengals roll with new QB in NFL re-draft exercise.

Murray's production has steadily decreased since his second year with the Cardinals, with the knee injury he suffered late in 2022 serving as the major culprit in the slowdown. The mock-world Bengals join the real-world Cardinals in hoping he stays healthy and consistent for a bounce-back season.

The Cincinnati Bengals don't usually fare well in the offseason exercise known as "re-draft" mock drafts. Generally, re-drafts that are a fun way to shake up the league and fill some dull offseason space have the Bengals picking later in the first round -- meaning another team swipes Joe Burrow very early. Case in point, a seven-round re-draft effort from NFL.com's Chad Reuter has Burrow going third overall to New England, while the Bengals pick 18th and settle for Kyler Murray: Murray still has some interesting upside as a franchise passer, but sitting 18th and getting the 16th quarterback off the board doesn't do the Bengals any favors in this exercise -- especially not when the team turns around and uses second and third-round picks on defenders.
