

declarations, pronouncements that welcome a new soul into the world and define the spiritual and cultural path that this new life will follow.

In Gîkûyû culture, the birth of a child is celebrated with the chanting of "Ngemis." This ritual is not only a family celebration but a spiritual ceremony that connects the newborn with their heritage, ancestors, and the universe. The number of Ngemis varies by gender: four for a girl and five for a boy, each representing a specific blessing or intention.

#### The Five Ngemis:

1. \*\*Ngemi of Uthamaki (Leadership):\*\* Every Gîkûyû child is blessed with the gift of leadership. This Ngemi instills the strength to take charge, to own one's path, and to lead in every aspect of life, no matter where they are in the world.

2. \*\*Ngemi of Ugo (Skill):\*\*

The second Ngemi bestows the gift of skill. It is a prayer for the child to acquire the talents and abilities needed to navigate life successfully, ensuring they are equipped to face challenges and seize opportunities.

#### 3. \*\*Ngemi of Urathi (Prophecy):\*\*

"All my inspiration comes from the fact that I am able to wake up every morning. The gift of going to sleep at night and rising in the morning is all I need to help me write of the goodness of life. Life itself is my inspiration and in every new breath lies a new story." – Kwame Rīgīi

Kwame is a talented creative artist who uses song to tell captivating stories of love, spirituality and tradition. His describes his style of music as "Urban Folk", which is a form of music that combines modern and traditional styles. His lyrics are compelling as they are inspiring.

He continues to bring back the beauty of the Gīkūyū language while inspiring an entire generation to find their identity and embrace it.

To be Gîkûyû is to be part of a lineage rich with culture, spirituality, and responsibility. The Ngemis serve as a reminder of the intentionality behind every Gîkûyû life—an intention to lead, to acquire skill, to foresee and prepare, to prosper, and for live fully, embracing the love and intentions that were set for them from the very beginning.


Ali Al'amin Mazrui (24 February 1933 12 October 2014), was a Kenyan-born

American academic, professor, and political writer on African and Islamic studies, and North-South relations. He was born in Mombasa, Kenya. His positions included Director of the Institute of Global Cultural Studies at Binghamton University in Binghamton, New York, and Director of the Center for Afro-American and African Studies at the University of Michigan. He produced the 1980s television documentary series The Africans: A Triple Heritage.

## Ron DeSantis-backed law barring Chinese from owning land in Florida

Wen Raiti, a Chinese American community leader in Jacksonville, Florida, has been a Republican for more than a decade. As a small business owner, she said,


the party's fiscal conservatism and small government ethos resonated with her. But last May, when Gov. Ron DeSantis signed legislation banning Chinese citizens from buying property in Florida, Raiti changed her party affiliation and began campaigning for local and national Democratic candidates.

Leading up to Florida's Aug. 20 primary election, anger toward Senate Bill 264 has turbocharged voter mobilization efforts in the Chinese American community in the state, organizers and elected officials said, pushing conservatives to defect from the GOP while inspiring first-time voters to register and volunteer for Democrats.

"This bill alone helped activate a lot of people in the Chinese American community who historically are not engaged with the government, especially the state government," said state Rep. Anna Eskamani (D-Orlando), who has been an outspoken critic of SB 264. Eskamani said hundreds of Chinese Americans have traveled to Tallahassee to protest, testify at committee hearings and spearhead fundraising drives. In the dozen years that she's been in government, she said, "I've never seen this kind of presence."

DeSantis opted for an audio-only conversation with Musk on Twitter Spaces. Initially drawing interest and curiosity, the call was a disaster. The feed crashed due to technical glitches, creating an inauspicious opening for what would ultimately be DeSantis' ill-fated campaign.



Peck, who was demoted three months into DeSantis' candidacy, and Musk are now working together again, this time on a super political action committee, America PAC, dedicated to electing Donald Trump, who beat DeSantis on his way to winning this year's Republican nomination.

Trump's campaign is largely leaving paid canvassing and get-out-thevote efforts to outside groups such as America PAC, relying on new guidance from the Federal Election Commission that allows campaigns to coordinate with outside groups in ways that were previously not allowed. But in doing so, the campaign has outsourced a core function to a coterie of untested groups that operate independently. Indeed, DeSantis' decision to have an outside group canvass for him was attributed as one of the reasons his presidential bid failed. AP

## Elderly doctor couldn't hear patient's screams during colonoscopy — because he wasn't wearing hearing aid, board finds

n elderly Tampa gastroenterologist is on probation after he failed to hear a patient screaming during a colonoscopy.

After 34 years with a medical license, Dr

Ishwari Prasad was placed on probation by the Florida Board of Medicine after a complaint accused him of medical malpractice, citing two procedures at the Ambulatory Surgery Center Tampa in June 2023 in which he failed to "effectively communicate" with his team and the patients because he wasn't wearing his required hearing aids.

During one colonoscopy, the gastroenterologist "began inserting the scope" before the patient was fully sedated. The patient started yelling — but Dr Prasad "did not immediately stop the procedure" because he wasn't wearing his hearing aids, the October 10, 2023 complaint says.

The nine-page complaint accuses Dr Prasad of falling below the minimum prevailing professional standard of care. "During one or both procedures, the surgical team was unable to effectively communicate with" Dr Prasad, the complaint states. If a doctor is unable to "effectively communicate" with their team without a hearing aid, "the minimum prevailing professional standard of care requires the physician to use an assistive hearing device during a procedure." During another procedure, Dr Prasad

dered on August 7, 2024, that Dr Prasad's license be placed on probation, prohibiting him from performing gastroenterology procedures without a supervisor present. He was also fined \$7,500 and ordered to pay \$6,301 in board administrative costs. On top of this, the physician must complete five hours of a Continuing Medical Education course in laws, rules, and ethics within a year. ۲



## Black History 10 Jimmy Lee Ruffin.

immy Lee Ruffin (May 7, 1936 – November 17, 2014) was an American soul singer, and the older brother of David Ruffin, the lead singer of the Temptations. He had se-

veral hit records between the 1960s and 1980s, the most successful being the Top 10 hits "What Becomes of the Brokenhearted" and "Hold On (To My Love)".

#### Biography

#### Early life

Jimmy Ruffin was born in 1936 in Collinsville, Mississippi, to Eli, a sharecropper, and Ophelia Ruffin. He was approaching his fifth birthday when his younger brother David was born. As children, the brothers began singing with a gospel group, the Dixie Nightingales.

In 1961, Jimmy became a singer as part

of the Motown stable, mostly on sessions but also recording singles for its subsidiary Miracle label, but was then drafted for national service. After leaving the Army in 1964, he returned to Motown, where he was offered the opportunity to join the Temptations to replace Elbridge Bryant. However, after hearing his brother David, they hired him for the job instead so Jimmy decided to resume his solo career. Ruffin recorded for Motown's subsidiary Soul label, but with little success.

#### Career

In 1966, he heard a song about unrequited love written for The Spinners, and persuaded the writers that he should record it himself. His recording of "What Becomes of the Brokenhearted" became a major success. The song reached #7 on the Billboard Hot 100 and #6 on the R&B Chart. It also initially reached #8 in the UK Singles Chart, rising to #4 when it was reissued in the UK in 1974. "What Becomes of the Brokenhearted" remains Ruffin's bestknown song. It was the lead single from his debut album Jimmy Ruffin Sings Top Ten (released as The Jimmy Ruffin Way in the UK), which was released on the Motown's Soul subsidiary label in 1967. Follow-up singles in America were successful, with "I've Passed This Way Before" and "Gonna Give Her All The Love I've Got" in late 1966 and early 1967.

which made the lower parts of the Billboard Hot 100 (#68) and was a Top 30 hit on the R&B Charts, peaking at #27. As a solo artist, it would prove to be Ruffin's last significant chart appearance in America for many years, and his last significant charting record for Motown in the US. The song was also released as the B-side to "What Becomes of the Brokenhearted" when it was reissued in 1974.

As Ruffin found success in the United States difficult to sustain, he began to concentrate instead on the British market. In 1970, "Farewell Is a Lonely Sound", "I'll Say Forever My Love" and "It's Wonderful (To Be Loved by You)" each made the UK Top Ten, and he was voted the world's top singer in one British poll. He also teamed up with brother David to record the album I Am My Brother's Keeper, a modestly successful 1970 album for Motown that included the songs "When The Love Hand Comes Down", "Your Love Was Worth Waiting For" and a cover of Ben E. King's "Stand by Me". His third solo album for the label, The Groove Governor, was released in 1970, and did not fare as well as his previous two albums.

He then left Motown, and recorded for the Polydor and Chess labels, where he recorded "Tell Me What You Want." In 1980, Robin Gibb of the Bee Gees produced his album Sunrise and the hit single "Hold On To My Love", which reached #10 in the US and #7 in the UK, on the RSO label.

In the 1980s, Ruffin moved to live in

da Holloway. Later, Ruffin hosted a radio show in the UK for a time, and became an anti-drug advocate following the 1991 drug overdose death of his brother David Ruffin was portrayed by Lamman Rucker in the 1998 mini-series The Temptations. Following the 2010 release - on CD for the first time - of his 1970 album I Am My Brother's Keeper, Ruffin had been writing and recording songs for a new album that he had planned to release during 2013. It was not finished at the time of his death.

In 2012, a compilation album titled There Will Never Be Another You, including his hit songs "What Becomes of the Brokenhearted", and "Hold On To My Love", had been released.

Ruffin's second album, Ruff 'n' Ready, was released in 1969. It contained the song "Don't You Miss Me a Little Bit Baby", Following the success of his initial hits, Ruffin found it hard to maintain an identity, as most of his songs were later covered by other Motown artists, most prominently "Everybody Needs Love", a hit when covered by Gladys Knight & the Pips for their 1967 debut album of the Great Britain, where he continued to perform successfully. In December 1984 he collaborated with Paul Weller of The Style Council for his benefit single "Soul Deep", produced to raise money for the families of striking miners affected by the UK miners' strike. This went under the name of The Council Collective and Jimmy appeared with Paul on Radio 1 to say he is involved because his father worked down the mines and "he understands the suffering."

In 1986 he collaborated with the British pop group Heaven 17, singing "A Foolish Thing to Do" and "My Sensitivity" on a 12" EP record. In 1987, Ruffin recorded "Easy Just To Say I Love You", which was written by Peter Marsh, Mae McKenna and Julian Marshall. He took part in recording for Ian Levine's Motown revival label, Motorcity Records, in the late 1980s and early 1990s. He recorded duets with both Maxine Nightingale and BrenRuffin lived in the area of Las Vegas, Nevada. On October 17, 2014, it was reported that he was gravely ill and had been taken into an intensive care unit at a Las Vegas hospital. He died on November 17, 2014, in Las Vegas, aged 78. Ruffin is buried at Palm Memorial Park Northwest Cemetery, Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada in the Garden of Eternal Life Section.



# Youth Led Revolution

Protesters continue to march in the capital Kampala holding placards written with messages such as "The Corrupt are Messing with a Wrong Generation".

frica's youth-led movements are growing on the youngest continent in the world, where 70% of the population are under the age of 30.

Driven by social media, a number of unrests have been witnessed across African States leading to historical political shake-ups that has never been experienced in the long history of the continent.

From Arab Spring uprisings in North Africa of 2011; the Sudanese Revolution that ousted General Omar al-Bashir in 2019; to the 2020 Nigerian #EndSARS protests against the abuse, extortion, #FeesMustFall protests in South Africa and the #RejectFinanceBill2024 protests in Kenya all were unheard with political elites holding power with no or little threat to the throne for decades.


The average age of a president in Africa is 62, and young protesters say they are frustrated with an aging leadership that does not hear their growing calls for change.

Just recently Kenyan political class had its major reckoning with Generation Z. After several days of protests against what they saw as obnoxious taxes in the Finance Bill, and "budgeted corruption", they got the government to withdraw the law. President William Ruto went ahead and dissolved the entire cabinet and also announced a series of cutbacks on items the Gen Z protesters had highlighted as wasteful.

And unlike previous political anti-government protests, no political affiliations or ethnic alignments were evident but just a clear determination by the protesters to be heard.

Several hours after the demonstrators had mobilised, the presidency appeared to bow to the pressure and announced that it would scrap some of the bill's



in their tear-gas-smelling clothes.

In Uganda, youth protesters are staging rallies outside parliament against alleged corruption and human rights abuses by leaders.

President Yoweri Museveni has ruled Uganda for almost four decades and has denied condoning corruption.

Protesters continue to march in the capital Kampala holding placards written with messages such as "The Corrupt are Messing with a Wrong Generation".

In 2017 mass protests to end the Special Anti-Robbery Squad (known as the #EndSARS protests) against police brutality in Nigeria was characterised by series of decentralised mass protests. The protest started in 2017 as a Twitter campaign using the #ENDSARS to demand the disbanding of the Special Anti-Robbery Squad that was known for brutality, harassment and extortion.

In February this year young people in Senegal, where more than 60% of the population is under 25, led nationwide anti-government protests after a decision to delay a highly anticipated presidential vote from February to December.

What began on university campuses soon spread to the streets of major cities. Demonstrators, including children, rejected former President Macky Sall's 10-month vote delay, which many said threatened the country's longstanding democracy.

In 2015 South Africa faced similar protest from the youth when University of the Witwatersrand in Johannesburg announced a 10.5% tuition fee increase for 2016. Protests began that same day, with the university's Student Representative Council (SRC) in full support of lower-income students who would not be able to afford the increase.

For three days, demonstrations took different forms across the university, from sit-ins, to marches, to locking-in the university's staff on campus. On Oct. 17, the university agreed to suspend the fee increase, renegotiate, and announce future plans two days later.

With the rise of youth-led protests who are determined to see transparency, accountability and good governance in Africa's corruption prone countries it remains to be seen how long the political class can hold onto power before the new dawn eclipses the continent.







## Patricia Bath Was A True Humantarian.

atricia Era Bath (November 4, 1942 – May 30, 2019) was an American ophthal-

mologist and humanitarian. She became the first female member of the Jules Stein Eye Institute, the first woman to lead a post-graduate training program in ophthalmology, and the first woman elected to the honorary staff of the UCLA Medical Center.

Bath was the first African-American to serve as a resident in ophthalmology at New York University. She was also the first African-American woman to serve on staff as a surgeon at the UCLA Medical Center. Bath was the first African-American woman doctor to receive a

The assassination of Martin Luther King Jr., in 1968, caused Bath to dedicate herself to achieving one of the dreams of King, namely the empowerment of people through the Poor People's Campaign. She organized and led Howard University medical students in providing volunteer health care services to the Poor People's Campaign in Resurrection City in the sumpatent for a medical purpose. A holder of five patents, she founded the non-profit American Institute for the Prevention of Blindness in Washington, D.C.

Early life and education Born 1942, in Harlem, New York, Patricia Bath was the daughter of Rupert and Gladys Bath. Her father was an immigrant from Trinidad, a newspaper columnist, a merchant seaman and the first black man to work for the New York City Subway as a motorman. Her father inspired her love for culture and encouraged her to explore different cultures.

Her mother was descended from African slaves and Cherokee Native Americans. Throughout her childhood, Bath was often told by her parents to "never settle for less than [her] best" and had been encouraged by their support of her education.

Her mother, encouraging her dreams and love of science, had bought her her first chemistry set. By the time she had reached high school, Bath was already a National Science Foundation scholar. This led to her cancer research earning a frontpage feature in the New York Times. Patricia and her brother attended Charles Evans Hughes High School where both students excelled in science and math.

Inspired by the French Nobel Peace Prize laureate Albert Schweitzer's work in medicine, Bath applied for



and won a National Science Scholarship Foundation while attending high school; this led her to a research project at Yeshiva University and Harlem Hospital Center studying connections between cancer, nutrition, and stress. In this summer program, led by Rabbi Moses D. Tendler, Bath had studied the effects of streptomycin residue on bacteria. Through this, she was able to conclude that cancer, itself, was a catabolic disease and tumor growth was a symptom.

She had also discovered a mathematical equation that could be used to predict cancer cell growth.[citation needed] The head of the research program realized the significance of her findings and published them in a scientific paper. Her discoveries were also shared at the International Fifth Congress of Nutrition in the fall of 1960. In 1960, at the age of eighteen years old, Bath won a "Merit Award" of Mademoiselle magazine for her contribution to the project.

Bath received her Bachelor of Arts in chemistry from Manhattan's Hunter College in 1964.

She then relocated to Washington, D.C. to attend Howard University College of Medicine.[6] Her first year at Howard coincided with the Civil Rights Act of 1964. She co-founded the Student National Medical Association and became its first woman tional Government Fellowship Award to do research in Belgrade, Yugoslavia, in the summer of 1967, where her research focused on pediatric surgery.[15] The highlight of the award ceremony was the meeting of Earl Warren, chief justice of the United States Supreme Court, at the US Embassy in Belgrade. Bath graduated with honors from Howard University College of Medicine in 1968.






